> "The lumber that was burned at Port Edward last fall was very dangerous,' he said. "It had been used for crating and bracing bombs and explosives and much of it was, and other parts were suspected of being, impregnated with explosives or inflammable chemicals."

The quantity of this lumber, Major Carewe estimated, was not in excess of 10.000 board feet. "We were prohibited from using it again and, because we considered it dangerous, we destroyed it. Every useable bit of lumber at both places has been stored, even a quantity of boards not more than six feet in length," Major Carewe said.
