# Air Force

Squadron Leader Kipp, Kamloops Overseas Hero, Meeting Local Senior High School Boys

One of ten officers who served with distinction overseas in the war and who have now been assigned to tour the province to talk to senior High School boys and place before them the possibilities of making permanent careers in the peacetime Royal Canadian Air Force, Squadron Leader R. A. Kipp, D.S.O., D.F.C., of Kamloops, who commanded the "City of Edmonton" Mosquito squadron during its second tour with the Royal Air Force, is in Prince Rupert today. Tonight at 5:45 he will speak for fifteen minutes over radio station CFPR and tomorrow morning at 11 o'clock will meet the senior boys of Booth Memorial High School.

Squadron Leader Kipp, speaking to the Daily News this morning, made it clear that it was not the intention or desire of the Royal Canadian Air Force to take young men out of school. In fact, they were being urged to at least complete their Junior Matriculation so that they might be in a position to take the fullest advantage of what the Air Force had to offer in the way of a career. With their matriculation standing, they would be able, through proficiency, to obtain commissioned rank in the Air Force.

Squadron Leader Kipp also pointed to the new policy in Air Force pay and allowances whereby there was a trend to equalization as between the commissioned and non-commissioned ranks, the whole scale comparable with the remunerations which civilian trades had to of-

Squadron Leader Kipp will leave tomorrow evening for the interior. His stops will be at F. Gerrie, Vanceuver; M. N. Terrace, Smithers, Telkwa, Burns Lake, Vanderhoof, Prince George, Vancouver; H. R. Dudoward, Williams Lake and Barkeville to Port Simpson; D. C. Seeman, meet and address the High School boys at all those points.
