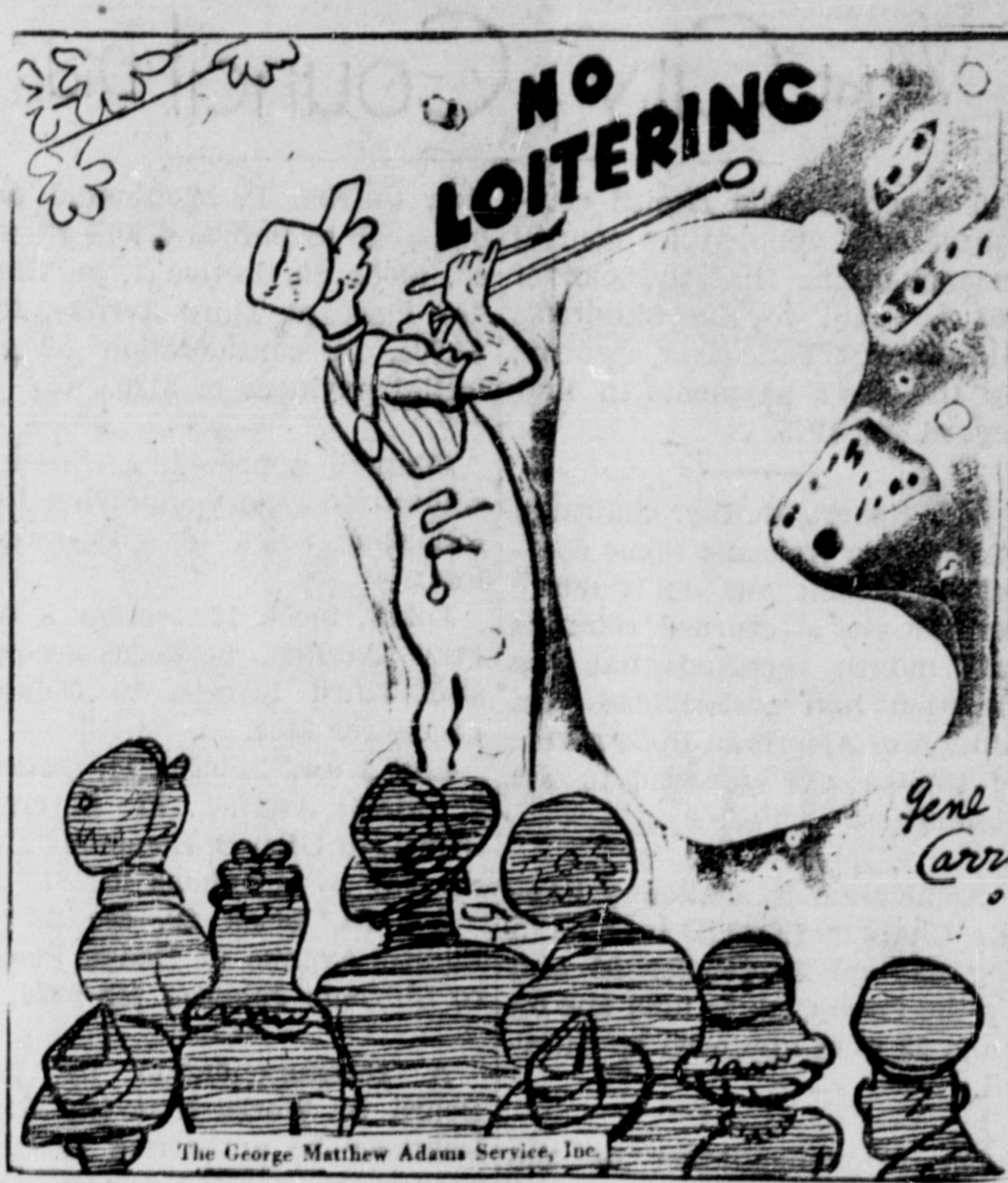

SHORT SPORT

 Skiers in New Zealand are hopeful of a better season's sport than last winter. Some of the best ski runs in the southern hemisphere are on the slopes of the 9,000-foot Mount Ruapehu, in the centre of the North Island. Although thermal activity was evident, this mountain was looked on as a dormant volcano, as there had been no large scale eruption within living memory. Last year, however, it burst into volcanic activity. Boulders as large as houses were hurled thousands of feet into the air and huge quantities of ash covered the snow all over the mountain, making skiing impossible. A lake which had filled the old crater disappeared and was replaced by a mass of red hot lava. Those who did visit the mountain had some unexpected thrills. One climber was struck by a red hot fragment from the crater and had to be brought down by a rescue party. Activity in the volcano now has greatly decreased and observers who have been studying it predict that the mountain will be safe for skiing this season. The crater still emits steam, water and mud geyser shots, but they rise only 100 feet or so.
