

Mother and Three Daughters Take Car Through Here To Alaska Highway

A mother and three daughters from California left here yesterday afternoon on the Princess Norah with their car for Ketchikan after having driven north from their home at Glendale and over the Prince Rupert Highway into Prince Rupert. They plan shipping the car from Ketchikan to Anchorage and thence driving southward over Highway.

Two of the daughters called at afternoon just before sailing for the north. They were not very enthusiastic about the condition the British Columbia roads which they had travelled in comng here, saying they would not want to have to make the return trip. They were innocently enough looking forward to the trip over the Alaska Highway which they said they had been informed was black-topped and hard-surfaced for its entire length. Evidently, they were unaware of any difficulties they might encounter in the way of driving restrictions or other complications.

The four women came north through Seattle, by-passing Vancouver to proceed direct up the Fraser Valley to the Cariboo Highway and thence to Prince Rupert by way of Prince George.

Gillnetters off the Naas mouth averaged 25 fish yesterday per boat, while those in the river averaged 15 fish. The day's average on the Skeena was 20 fish per boat.
