Lovin, in a quiet ceremony performed by Rev. A. F. MacSween in the home of the bridegroom's parents.

The bride, who met her husband during the war while he was serving overseas with the B. C. Dragons, looked lovely in a dress of blue crepe with fuchsia trimmings with shoulder bouquet. She was attended by Mrs. R. J. Lovin, sister-in-law of the bridegroom, wearing a dress of fuchsia trimmed with black, with corsage.

Groomsman was R. J. Lovin, brother of the bridegroom. Mr. and Mrs. Lovin will make their home at Prince George and will leave this week for the interior city.

The bride arrived in Prince Rupert on Christmas Eve by train from Edmonton, after a plane flight from Scotland during which the plane was grounded for four days in Iceland due to engine trouble. The bridegroom enlisted in Prince Rupert in the Royal Canadian Corps of Signals and went overseas with the B. C. Dragons. For the last year, since his discharge, he has been employed in Prince Rupert.
