> The ordination service opened with a processional hymn, "Crown Him With Many Crowns", as the choir, followed by the candidate, Rev. Mr. Prockter, Canon Rushbrook and Bishop Gibson, in that order of precedence, proceeded down the aisle to the chancel.

In the sermon which followed.


