Waterfront Whiffs

Good News For Local Shippers to
Southeastern Alaska—Interest
In This Port Waxes

Impaled on the sharp edge of hunger by the latest American west coast shipping strike, the territory of Alaska is becoming more clamorous in its demands that the Port of Prince Rupert be used as the export centre for foodstuffs and the imported goods which the territory needs: Alaskans have expressed the

frank opinion on more than one occasion that the monopoly enjoyed by Seattle on shipments to Alaska would be better for the north if shared by Prince Rupert. Prince Rupert business men, seeing eye-to-eye with the Alaskans on this subject, were immensely cheered on Friday to learn that the Canadian Department of Trade and Commerce "will do everything possible to facilitate" exports from Prince Rupert to Alaska, and applauded Trade Minister James A. MacKinnon's decision which will relieve the hampering necessity of submitting detailed statements of every shipment made from here to the processing officer of the exports licensing branch. The wire tolls which these reports make necessary and the time loss and extra work involved have been real impediments in Prince Rupert wholesalers' efforts to build up a substantial trade with Alaska at the present time. The permit requirements as outlined by Mr. MacKinnon, Friday allows merchants to submit applications covering their estimated exports for three-month periods at a time.

A specific item in the growing awareness that southeastern Alaskans have for Prince Rupert was exemplified in a telegram received last night by Mayor H. M. Daggett from a metal working shop at Anchorage. The telegram asked the mayor to try and place an order for three tons of galvanized metal sheets in the hands of some Prince Rupert wholesaler for immediate shipment to Anchorage. Owing to the extreme difficulty of getting such material in Prince Rupert at the present time, it is very doubtful if the order can be filled, but it is pleasing to note that Prince Rupert is now considered as a source of supply by Alaskan business people.
