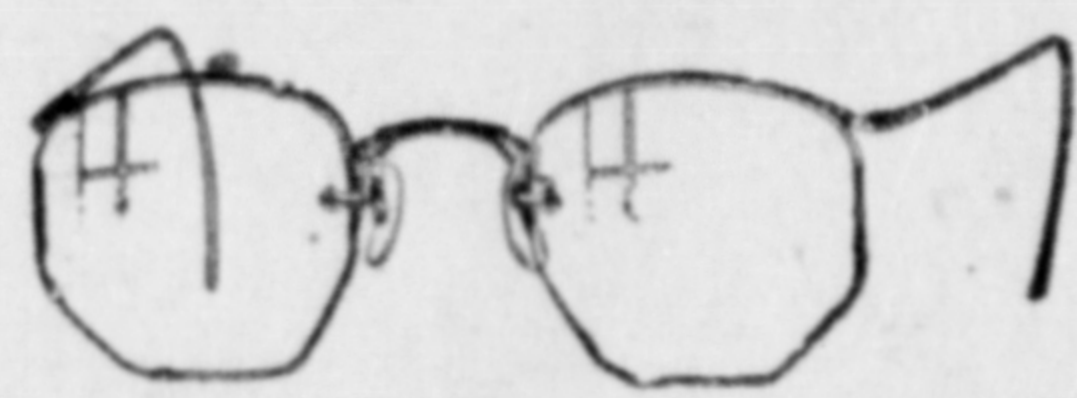

### SUBMARINE EPIC HERE

In "We Dive at Dawn," Wednesday and Thursday's British feature picture at Capitol Theatre starring the Halifax actor, Eric Portman, the British submarine "Sea Tiger" docks after a long voyage and the crew are given seven days' leave but all private engagements are cancelled and the crew suddenly recalled to their ship which sails with instructions to try and sink a Nazi battleship. 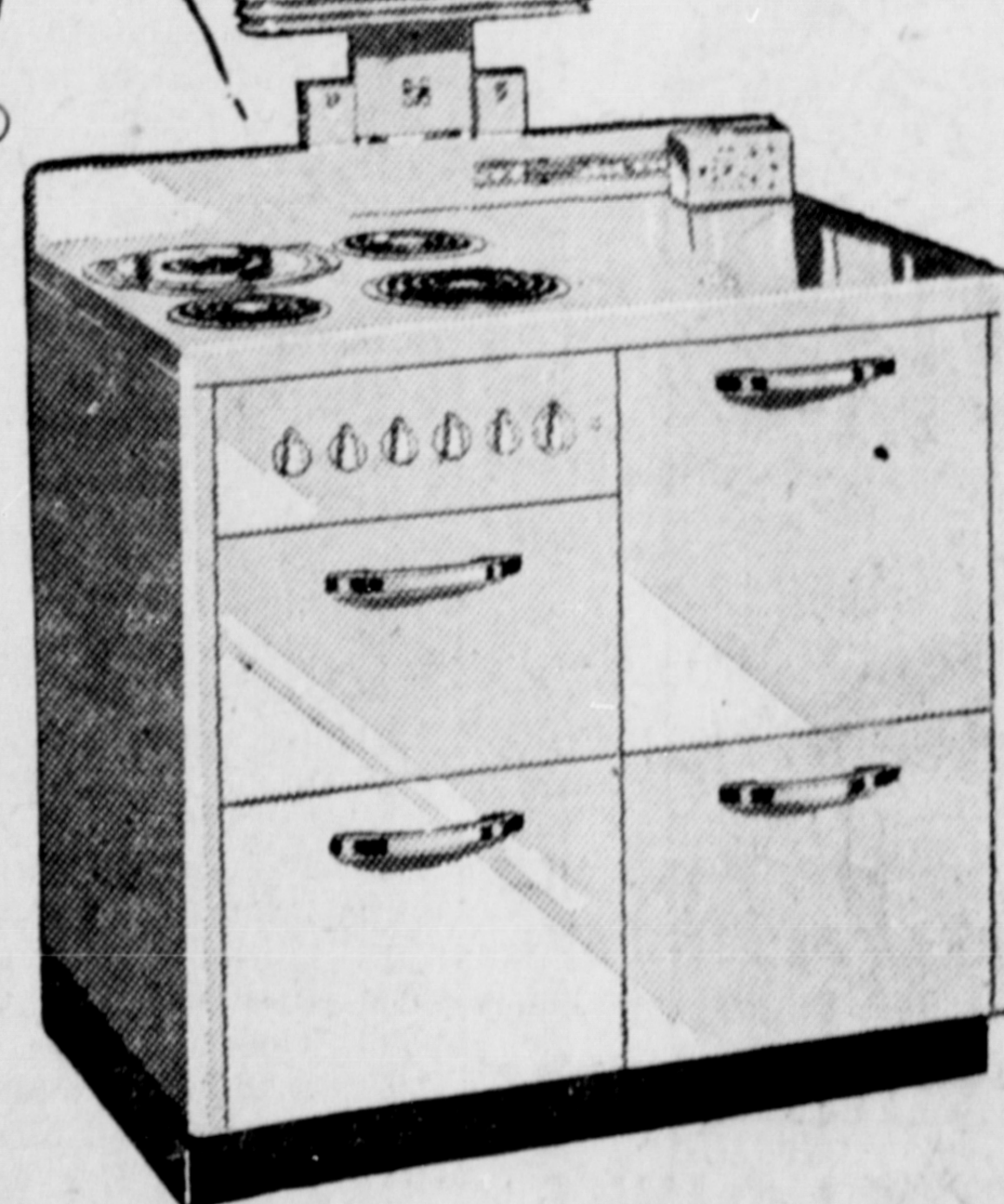
