LONDON, April 19, (P)-American heavy bombers smashed at enemy aircraft factories in Western Germany "in very great strength" today. The bombers hammered fighter plane factories at Kassel and plants manufacturing aircraft parts at Eschwege, southeast of Kassel, as well as Paderborn, Gutersloh, Lippitad and Werl.
