Tie spices (including dried chili peppers when used) loosely in a cheescloth bag. Adu spice bag, sugar and salt to vinegar, bring to boiling point and add other ingredients. Bring slowly to boiling point and boil for 45 minutes or until pickle has thickened. Remove spice bag, pack pickles in hot, sterilized jars and seal. Yield: about 4 pints.
