Timely Recipes

LAMB STEW

This makes liberal servings for four.

- 1 to 1½ pounds of stewing lamb cut up for stewing.
- 1 bunch of carrots, scraped and cut in pieces.
- 8 small white onions or 4 medium sized yellow onions, whole.
- 6 to 8 small or medium size potatoes, whole or halved.
- 1 teaspoon Worcester Sauce, optional.
- Salt and pepper.

Directions: Wet the cut lamb and then place the wet pieces into flour and press as much flour into each piece as it will take up. Place in a pot, with a lid, some beef or other good drippings, when hot place the pieces of floured lamb in and allow to brown well on each side. Then add boiling water, sufficient to just cover the meat. Prepare the vegetables immediately the meat is started and place the vegetables in with the meat, place lid on pot and allow to slowly simmer for 1½ to 2 hours.
