"The unity of the Commonwealth and its methods of co-operation, proven, strengthened and given new significance by the common effort of the war, represent, in Mr. KING'S view, though the words he chose were aptly quoted from an address of Mr. CHUR-CHILL in 1907, 'a model of what we hope the whole world will some day become.' In Mr. KING'S address, as in that of Mr. CHURCHILL, the Commonwealth and Empire are defined not in terms of a limited association but of the evolution of free nations looking forward "to larger brotherhoods and more exact standards of social justice." Not merely is the security of nations indivisible but also their prosperity; and the nations of the Commonwealth as part of "a larger company" embracing the United States, the Soviet Union, China, France, and all other nations united today in the defence of freedom 'must help to fashion a new world order in which social security and human welfare become a part of the inheritance of mankind.' (Mr. KING'S address, is at once a definition of the nature of the British Commonwealth and the world, consistent both with the long history of the widening freedom of each British nation and with the spirit of the Atlantic Charter and the Moscow Declaration. "Canada's history and Canada's voluntary and unstinted share in this war both symbolize the nature of the Commonwealth and exemplify the world character of its role. "It remains the duty of the Commonwealth whereever possible 'to give the lead that is in the interest of the world as a whole,' in security and in welfaresince it is more and more apparent that a broad community of thought and action in social purposes must be one great element in that leadership. "Mr. KING'S address is a fine and helpful contribution to the philosophy of the Commonwealth and Empire and to the thought of all free peoples. Among these free peoples none has more right than Canada to define the purposes of the United Nations or the principles of the unity of the Commonwealth. Canada has not sought and does not wish to influence the policies of her great neighbour and friend of her partners in the American hemisphere, but twice at a solemn moment in world history, the political imagination and experience of the Canadian people, instantly and freely responding to a challenge, physically distant but morally immediate, has anticipated those policies and has anticipated them by a declaration of war that enhanced rather than weakened the unity of the Canadian people."
