Jungle Hero Outsmarts Desert Renegades in Latest Picture

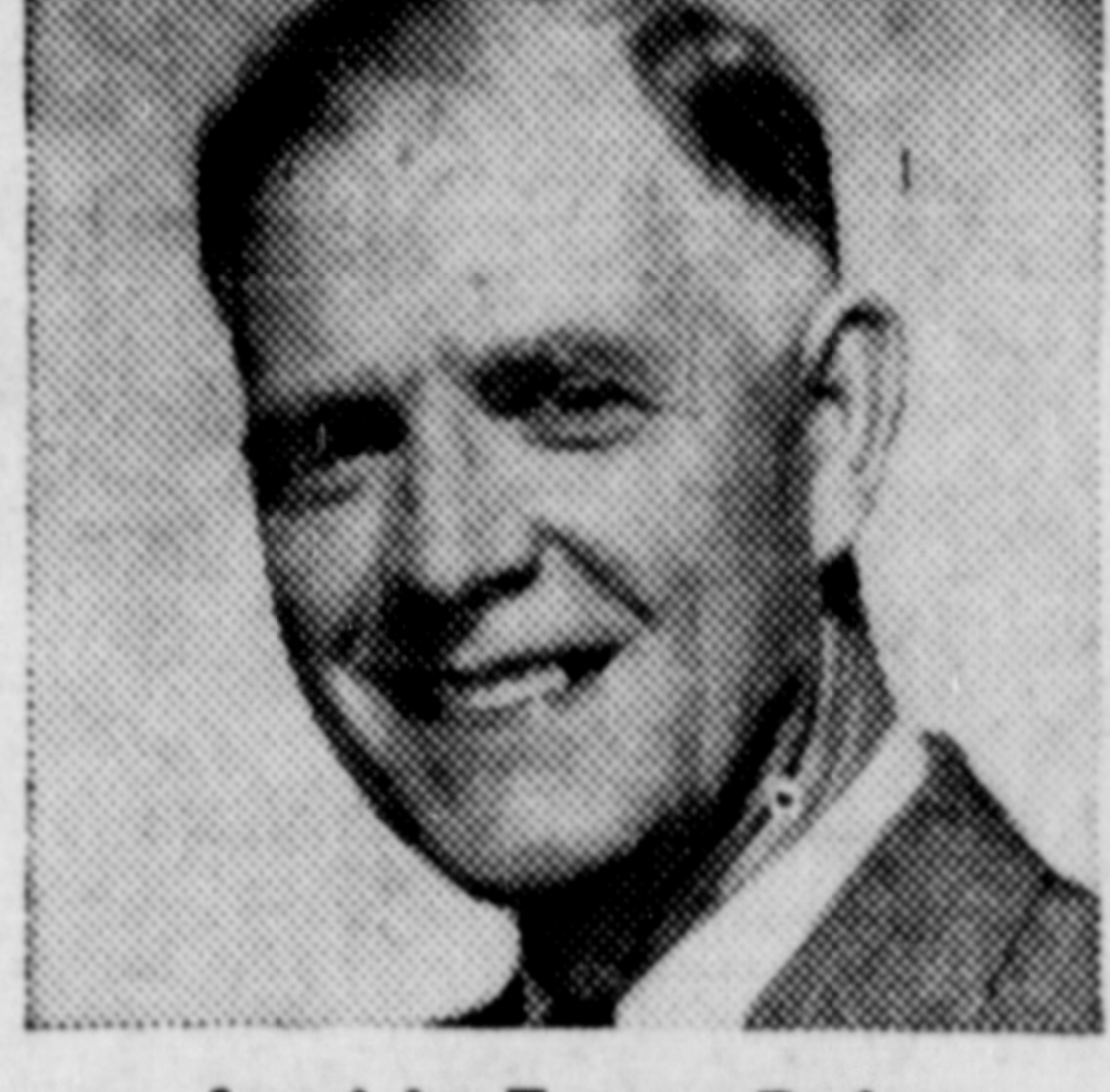
A clash between sinister, enemy agents and Tarzan, provides the theme of "Tarzan's Desert Mystery" at the Capitol on Monday and Tuesday.

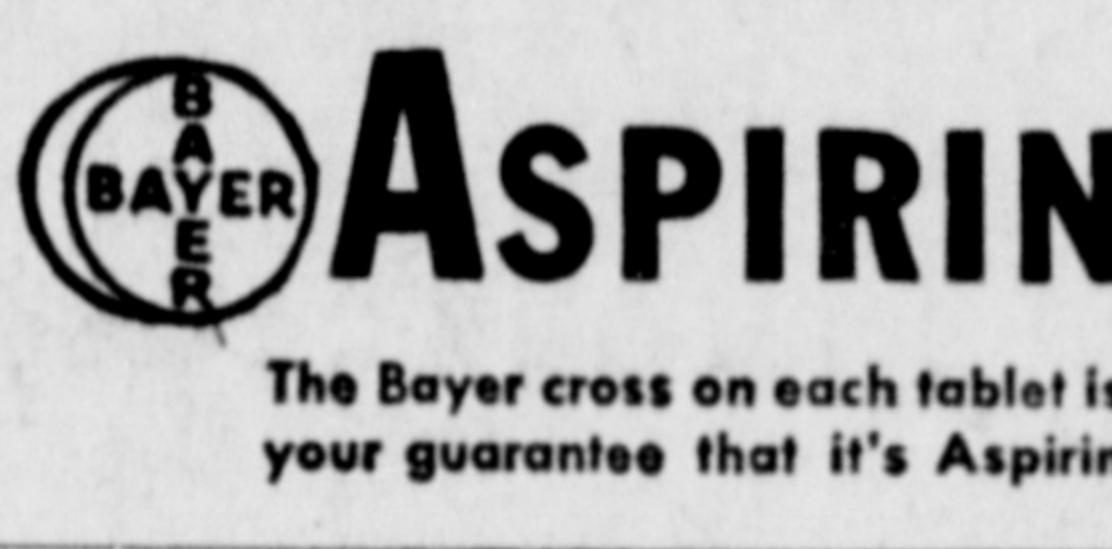
