> Grass rugs, woven of heavy marsh grasses on a stout cotton thread generally have a painted-on pattern which is showing signs of wear at this time of year. House paint thinned with turpentine will put the design back on if you have a secret ambition to paint. Other common summer rugs made of sisal, coconut or palm fibre can be given a quick once over with soapsuds ... but don't soak them. Painting is harder but it

can be done. JAM MAKING: By way of preface to their valuable and timely little booklet, Wartime Jams, Jellies and Pickles, the Agriculture Department has these general suggestions which will help the most inexperienced cook over the hurdle of jam making:

Select firm, ripe fruit and be careful to measure fruit and sugar carefully. Wash fruit, cut or mash to start the flow of juice. To prevent sticking a little water may be added. A little cider vinegar may be added to less acid fruits such as peaches and pears. Heat fruit very slowly to extract juices. Stir fre quently, using a wooden spoon.
