

The second place Senators went down to a 5-3 defeat at the hands of the New York Yankees, dropping them a game and a half behind the idle Detroit club. The Senators have only three more games to play, all with Philadelphia.

Chicago still stands with a two game lead in the National League over the second place St. Louis Cardinals. Brooklyn and Philadelphia played the only games scheduled in the senior circuit yesterday and Brooklyn took them both, winning 1-0 and 11-5.
