Directions Given for Serving Fruits and Vegetables in Jelly

A sparkling gelatine salad, encasing fruits or vegetables within its quivering walls, is the perfect answer to summer meals. It is simple to make an dtakes but a moment to unmold on crisp salad greens.

Make your salad in individual miniatures or turn out a family size mold on a large platter and garnish to make the ideal centrepiece for your table. For a cool main course on a hot day, fill a salad and devilled eggs, or cottage cheese.

Here are diretgions for three kinds of gelatine bases. These offer unlimited variety, using the fruits and vegetables in season.

Foundation Aspic for Vegetables
