### Excluding the Press . . .

The mayor of Prince Rupert last week expressed on behalf of the city council official indignation over criticism by this newspaper of the city council's practice of going frequently into secret session to discuss public business. It is interesting to note that Vancouver newspapers have just taken Mr. Justice A. M. Manson to task for excluding the press from a civil case in Victoria.

"Publicity, it is important that both judges and politicians should know, is the ventilating system of these modern days. It lets air and sunlight into institutions that would overwise grow stuffy and noisome. It keeps courts and legislatures wholesome and competent. It makes certain that they operate in the public interest.

"The importance of publicity was asserted long ago when the British people revolted against the star chamber and demanded its abolition. It is as vital today as it was three centuries ago that the courts should be open and that the press, as the representatives of the public, should have access to them. It is not necessary or desirable that all or nearly all the proceedings of every court be published. The selection can be left to the newspapers. It is much safer in their hands than in the hands of any court officer."


