Devenish, Allen and Boulter  
Speak at Dry Dock  
Presentation

In introducing W. R. Devenish, C.N.R. vice-chairman, at the Devenish Cup presentation at the local dry dock, Bernard Allen, shipyard manager, stressed the great pleasure it gave to all to have Mr. Devenish come to make the presentation. He regretted that Mr. Devenish's itinerary brought him here on a holiday, but, in view of other commitments, that had been unavoidable. He was glad to see so many in attendance. For himself, the reports that he had received while in Montreal of the progress of the Eighth Victory Loan campaign in the yard had given him very great pleasure. He had been proud of the yard and wished to congratulate T. J. Boulter, the canvassers, and the employees generally on their splendid achievement. He felt that the offering of the Devenish Cup had provided an effective stimulus to the sale of bonds.

Before presenting the cup, Mr. Devenish expressed the great pleasure it gave him to come to Prince Rupert to present another cup for outstanding achievement in leading for the second time all the divisions in western region of the Canadian National Railways in the Victory Loan campaign. If, as Mr. Allen had stated, the offering of the cup had given an additional incentive he was very happy about it. The campaign had been followed with keen interest by the 29,000 employees of the western region. The shipyard had established an enviable reputation for building and repairing ships and a unique record in Victory Loan campaigns. As a railwayman he was very proud and pleased.
