LONDON, Nov. 19 (P-London laundrers are opposed to the reintroduction of men's evening dress in theatres and restaurants at the present time. "Men who wear boiled shirts will do so at their own risk,' said the official of a large London laundry. "Already we have more essential clothing than we can cope with without taking on extra specialized work. 'All boiled shirts have to be hand-ironed which means additional labor. And there is no starch available for this work."
