The New Bishop Here . . .

A happy appointment appears to have been made for the new Roman Catholic Bishop of Prince Rupert in the person of Rev. Anthony Jordan, O.M.I., formerly one of Vancouver's best known pastors, now in Ottawa.

Succeeding the late Bishop Emil Bunoz, O.M.I., who died June 3, Bishop-Designate Jordan has the ad-

vantage of comparative youth for he is only forty-three years of age.

Nor does his youth imply lack of administrative experience since, after leaving Vancouver, he has for the past four years been head of the Holy Rosary Scholisticate in the Oblate Seminary at Ottawa. In Vancouver, where he spent ten years he was not only in charge of St. Augustine's Parish but was treasurer of the province of English - speaking Oblate Fathers in Canada.

Born in Edinburgh and coming to Canada as a youth to be educated at Edmonton, he is fully Englishspeaking and that should be an advantage in a diocese such as this.

It is expected the new Bishop will be coming to Vancouver soon and thence to this city to assume his ecclesiastical seat.


