

SHORT SPORT

Lt. Cpl. Danny Webb, Montreal's gift to British boxing, has decided to stay in England and go title-hunting among United Kingdom featherweights. He has been demobilized from the Canadian army, in which he served with the 17th Duke of York's Hussars. As an opener to his fistic career as a civilian in London, Webb has suggested a return match with Al Phillips at 126 pounds, for £500 (\$2,250) a side. He'll also be glad to discuss terms with any other featherweight. Danny lost to Phillips in their first bout at the Royal Albert Hall in London, Phillips scoring a knockout in the sixth round.

Newmarket's latest record-breaking bloodstock sales ended with buyers paying £605,402 (\$2,723,309) for 728 lots during the five-day sale. Highest price on the clipping day was 2,100 guineas (\$9,660) which H. J. Joel paid for Fairholm, a six-year-old mare by Fair Trial, Lord Derby's three-year-old Blue Water was sold privately as a stallion and has been shipped to Ireland.

Edinburgh's race fans are hoping the War Office will de-requisition the racetrack stands and stables in time for a meet on April 15. Four meets have been planned—one in the spring,

one in summer and two fall race programs—if, of course, the de-requisition order comes through in time.

Tucked away in a little room in the concrete rafters of the great Stamford Bridge football stand, two women who have yet to see a game this season have become adept at interpreting the sounds of the crowd to learn what's going on in the stadium. Mrs. F. A. Metcalfe, a football manager's secretary, and Mrs. C. Naylor, who serves tea to sports writers, listens to stamps, roars, exclamations, groans or figets of the crowd above their heads to follow the play. "The stamping usually means the ball has been kicked out of play," they explained, "and people are warning their feet until the game starts again." Outside, Brentford and Chelsea were playing. An echoing roar brought Mrs. Metcalfe's fanatic, "Brentford goal. Not enough noise for Chelsea."

Resignation of Willie Hall—one of the finest inside forwards to have played for England and the 'Spurs—as manager of Clapton Orient, was a blow to soccer fans. Hall took the job two months ago, but now is threatened with the loss of his right leg from thrombosis.

Moscow Dynamos took off for Russia with nearly two tons of luggage, including 17 racing bicycles presented to them by a South London firm.
