- RAISIN SPICE LOAF 1 cup seedless raisins.
- 1 cup golden raisins 1 cup lukewarm milk 2 cakes compressed yeast 14, cup granulated sugar
- 4 tablespoons butter or margarine
- 2 +ablespoons salt 11/2 teaspoons cinnamon
- leaspoon mace 14 teaspoon cloves
- 1 egg 51/2 to 53/4 cups sifted allpurpose flour

Rinse raisins in hot water; ain and dry on a towel. Combine milk and crumbled yeast and stir to dissolve yeast. Cream sugar, butter, salt and spices. Add beaten egg and mix. Add reast-milk mixture and 2 cups lour and beat. Add raisins and stir to blend. Add remaining flour and mix. Lift to board and knead 4 to 5 minutes. Return to mixing bowl-cover and let rise in warm place until double in bulk (this dough is rich and heavy with fruit, so will require more time for rising than ordinary yeast bread) about 23/4 to hours. For minto one large loaf to fit a pan about 234 to 3 hours. Let rise in warm place until double in size (about 11/2 hours). Bake in a moderate oven (350 degrees F.) 50 to 60 minbrush top with melted butter.


