## MARKET DROP HALTS FUR MARKET SALES

A responding drop in the London fur market has left Canadian and American fur dealers holding large quantities of pelts for which they can find no reasonable market, according to J. E. Ormheim, local Hudson's Bay Co. fur buyer who is closing up his seasonal operations a month earlier than usual this year because of the situation.

The recent Hudson's Bay Co. fur sale in London saw prices on practically all types of furs 20 per cent below the market price last winter, he said, blaming the drop on vast Russian fur exports during the last few months.

"With the exception of mink, all furs sold for 20 per cent less than they did at the sale last winter, and only about 40 per cent of the furs offered were sold," he said.

Canadian and American operators lost heavily as a result of the market drop.

Prices and demand for mink remain unchanged from last winter's level, he added.

He attributed the drop to Russian exports of furs, which, he said, have had a value of \$87,000,000 and have been dumped on the fur trading capitals of the world. This has reduced the demand for North American fur.

"According to information I have received, the Russians have exported 67,000 marten pelts, and 7,000,000 squirrels. Further exports on a similar scale are feared," he declared.

Market conditions are causing Mr. Ormheim to close up his buying operations for the summer. Ordinarily he does not do so until June. He is sailing tonight on the Prince Rupert where he will spend the summer.

constantly. Beat egg yolks with cold water and blend with first mixture. Sift together the dry ingredients and fold into first mixture with the vanilla. Line shallow pan (10½" x 15½") with waxed paper, allowing edge of paper to extend 2" above sides of pan. Grease pan and paper thoroughly. Pour batter into pan and bake in a hot oven 400 degrees F. for 12-15 minutes. Turn out on damp cloth, trim off edges and roll cake with cloth as for jelly roll. Cool. Unroll and spread with whipped cream to which the sugar has been added. Re-roll and slice.
