

## CONSTRUCTION TOTAL \$16,000

Twenty-three building permits, valued at \$16,960, issued at the City Engineer's office during April, brought value of construction in Prince Rupert for the first four months of the year to \$50,792, a decrease of 2.00 \$21,000 under the same period 3.00 for 1946.


