Pitchers Betty Hamilton of the Moose and Betty Sedgwick of High School waged a scoreless three-inning duel at Gyro fast-ball park last night, building up a tension that snapped in the fourth when Hamilton walked Mostad, a gesture that allowed High School's initial run and set a wave of pandemonium through the bleachers.

Final tally was High School 5, Moose 3.

Moose remained scoreless until the fifth inning when Jordan, who got on base on a walk, scored off a fielder's error. North, who got on base on an error, brought in the team's second run.

Hamilton let down in the seventh with fatal results for Moose since it cost them four runs and the game. A succession of errors by her teammates allowed scoring by Skora and Farrington, who got on base on singles, and by Betty Sedgwick and her sister, both of whom were walked. Moose field work during this climactic period consisted largely of base overthrows.


