FISH INFRACTION CHARGE DROPPED

A charge laid under the fisheries regulations was dismissed by Magistrate W. D. Vance in e-is city police court after he had ruled that the court had no jurisatetion over the case because the infraction was alleged to have occurred outside Canadian territorial waters.

The charge was laid against Walter Lundigan, skipper of the halibut boat Gosnell, who was accused of fishing in a restricted halibut nursery area off Tow Hill last May 25. The place was about nine miles off the northeast coast of the Queen Charlottes and, therefore, beyond the territorial limits.

The charge was dropped at request of defence counsel, T. W. Brown, who claimed that the case was outside the jurisdiction the court.

Rod MacLeod appeared for the Department of Fisheries, which laid the charge.


