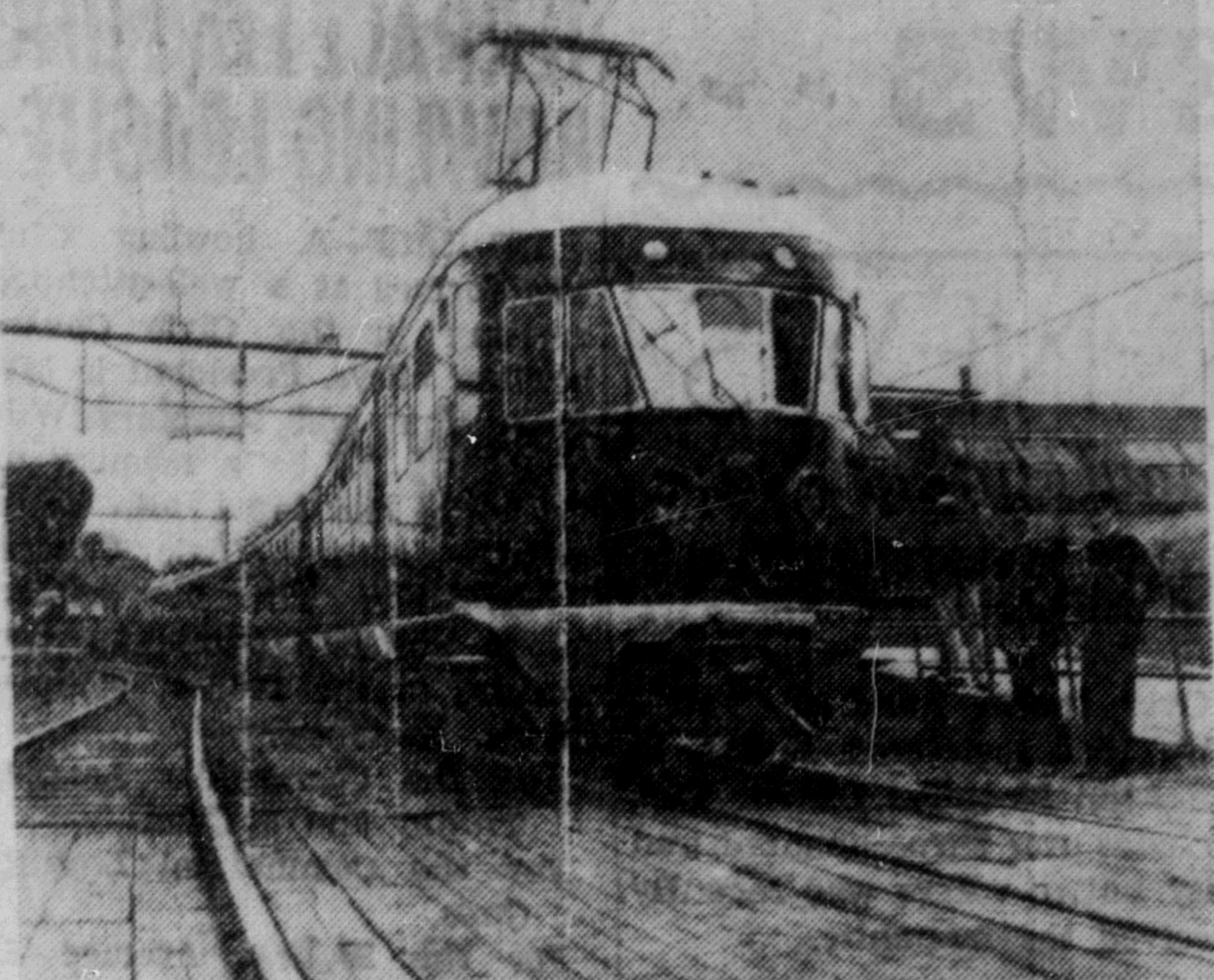

## To Speed European Economic Recovery



This gleaming, electric powered train has been added to the war-damaged transportation system of the Netherlands as the result of a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development, a Specialized Agency of the United Nations. The Bank has been concentrating its loans on long-term projects, which will contribute to over-all economic development.

## APRIL BUILDING TOTAL \$15,000

Value of building construction authorized by the city engineer's office in April was \$15,000, about \$2,500 less than in March, but more than twice as much as in April, 1948. Total value of permits issued so far this year is \$49,423 as compared with \$67,355 for the corresponding period of last year.

Of the 16 permits issued last month, two were for relatively large projects, one being for \$7,200 for installation of oil tanks for Standard Oil Co. and the other for construction of a coal shed for Albert and McCaffery Ltd. for \$4,000. A \$2,000 permit was issued to Oscar Hanson for repairs and alterations to his Fraser Street property. Balance of the permits were for less than \$1,000.

### The GARDEN

Add Something New— Those who get the most fun and satisfaction always plan to add something new each season. In this way they become familiar with the steady improvement plant breeders and experimenters are making, and they also make valuable discoveries for themselves. It should be remembered that the work of plant improvement has never stopped. Old favorites among the flowers and vegetables have been wonderfully improved in color or quality and what is of great importance to Canada, there are far harder sorts today than were in existence a few years ago. As a result of this new hardness it is now possible to grow such tender things as garden corn, melons, tomatoes, cucumbers, etc., in areas where the old strains would not have had a chance. And the same applies to many formerly tender flowers.

New Discoveries— Then there are brand-new discoveries, too, at least brand-new to the average gardener. A great many people have never tried things like borecole, Brussel's sprouts, Chinese cabbage, endive, watermelon, or even Swiss Chard, peppers or eggplants. Few have ever tried to grow any of the herbs like dill or sage, or things like garlic, horse-radish or leeks. Practically all of these are hardy and easily produced. By selecting new hardy varieties or in some cases getting started plants or forcing along under paper caps and with a little quick-acting fertilizer, these things can be grown safely in a great many parts of Canada. And the list of new or improved flowers is almost endless, as any good seed catalogue will reveal. It is not advisable to plant the whole garden with new things or novelties, but certainly the systematic introduction of two or three each year will provide new interest and very often the discovery of a valuable and permanent addition.

## Under New Management

## DO YOU KNOW about TRAVEL RATION REGULATIONS?

It saves time and trouble when you familiarize yourself with the regulations regarding travel to the United States before you set out on your trip. Here are the facts:

1. The allowance for pleasure travel during the current ration period of November 16th, 1948, to November 15th, 1949, is \$150 U.S. per person (\$100 in the case of children under 11 years old).
2. A Form H permit, obtainable at any bank, is required to take out of Canada amounts exceeding \$10 U.S. or \$25 U.S. and Canadian funds.
3. Special allowances are granted for strictly business travel where your application is certified by your employer.
4. Applications for larger amounts of U.S. funds for travel for health or educational purposes may be made on special forms obtainable at your bank.
