Big Hitting For Change

Seventh Inning Barrage Gives Boston Victory—Five Homers Scored

CLEVELAND (Left) Spahn, who was called to the mound in the fourth inning after the Indians had mauled Nelson Potter into a critical spot, held Cleveland to a lone hit and yielded one walk in the final five stanzas for the most brilliant pitching job so far in the annual baseball classic. Boston Braves lashed Bobby Feier out of the mound in a fateful seventh inning Sunday for five hits and six runs and went on to win an 11 to 5 victory in the fifth World Series game here. The Boston victory sent the clubs back to Braves Field for the sixth game yesterday.

The Sunday game was an entirely different sort of an affair from the tight pitching and sparse hitting lack-lustre contests which had marked the first four games. With the power hitters taking over, there were no less than five home runs, two by Bob Elliott, Boston's third sacker, and one each by Dale Mitchell and Jim Hegon of Cleveland and Bill Salkeld of Boston. It was a bitter loss for Feier who has been humbled twice by the Braves instead of achieving his culminating ambition of winning a World Series game.

The game broke all records for any Big League baseball game in history—86,288 persons paying a total gate of \$378,778.73.

Sixth (Boston)—Rickert struck out. Salkeld sent a long drive deep into right field for a homer which evened the score. McCormick was out at first on a neat play from Boudreau. Stanky was walked again. Spahn fanned for Feller. One run, one hit, no errors.

Seventh—Holmes hit safely into left-centre. Dark bunts out, Homes to second. Torgeson lines out a single to score Holmes. (Feller is pulled out of the game and Ed. Kileman takes up task).
