"I feel that there is plenty of work for two more dentists here," Dr. Black said. "The work of the three existing dentists is excellent, but they are greatly overworked. If the teeth of the city's children are to be adequately cared for, it is up to you to act."

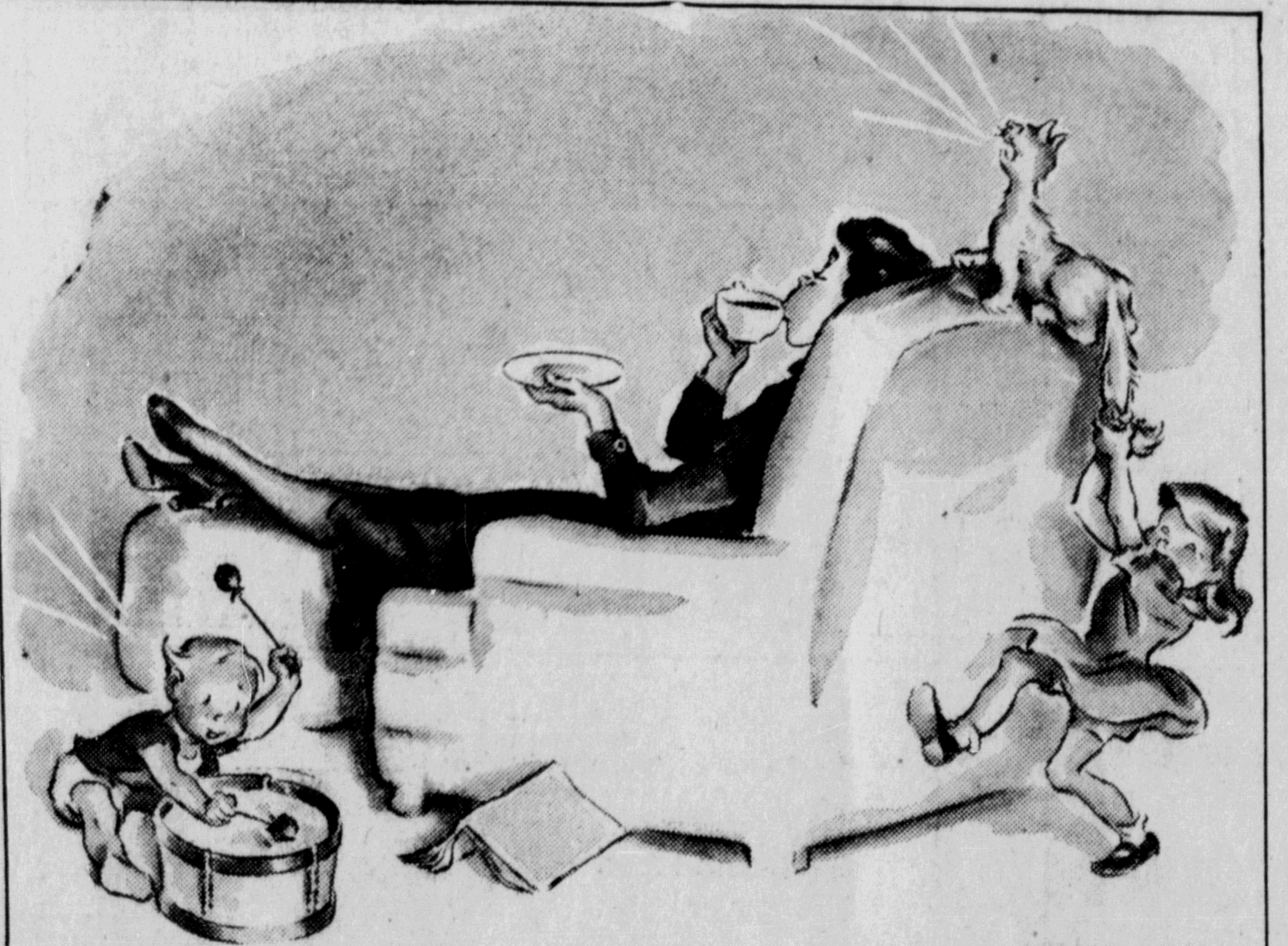
