CHEESEBREAD

• Scald 3 c. milk, ¼ c. granulated sugar, 1½ tbs. salt and 4 tbs. shortening; cool to lukewarm. Meanwhile, measure into a large bowl ½ c. lukewarm water, 1 tsp. granulated sugar; stir until sugar is dissolved. Sprinkle with 1 envelope Fleischmann's Royal Fast Rising Dry Yeast. Let stand 10 mins., THEN stir well. Stir in cooled milk mixture. Stir in 4 c. once-sifted bread flour; beat with a rotary beater until the batter is smooth. Divide each portion of dough into 3 parts; knead and shape into smooth balls. Place 3 balls in each of 4 greased loaf pans (4½" x 8½"). Grease tops and sprinkle each loaf with ¼ c. shredded cheese. Cover and let rise until doubled in bulk. Bake in moderately hot oven, 375°, 45-50 mins.

Exemption from city taxes was asked by Prince Rupert General Hospital for six lots near the hospital.

Although these lots are not occupied, the hospital wishes to retain them for future expansion. But the hospital commission will not accept payment of such taxes as a legitimate operating expense.

On the suggestion of Ald. T. B. Black, the matter was referred to the finance committee to determine how much would be involved. Possibility of a grant to cover the taxes was suggested. Straight tax exemption would require reference to the ratepayers.
