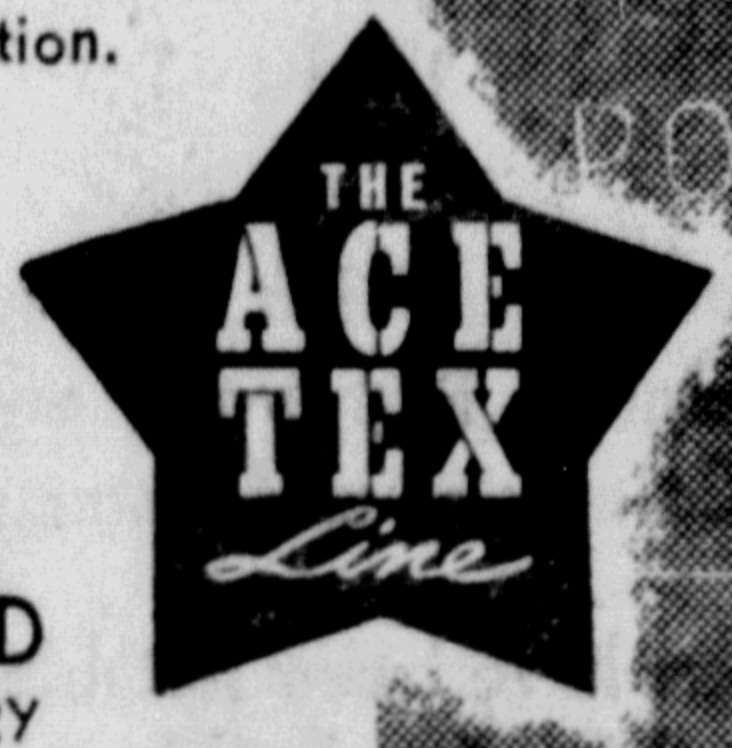

Seasonable Ideas for Housekeepers

APPLES FOR APPETITE; ARE NOW SEASONABLE FOR EASTER

Legends associated with apples are many. The Turks of early ages believed that apples were the true fountain of youth. They ate them to keep or regain the vitality of adolescent days. Another of the old customs was the eating of apples on Easter morning to be assured of good health for the remaining part of the year. With so many of these legends relating to health it is no wonder that the slogan "An apple a day keeps the doctor away" lives on year after year.

In this country, Easter never was the right season for luscious apples. The best time to bite into a crisp apple was when the first snow was falling. Modern cold storage facilities have changed the situation so that some varieties of apples are still firm and juicy at Easter time. In any case there are plenty of good apples ready for delicious apple dishes.

Home economists say that some of the general rules for cooking apples are often ignored.

General Rules for Cooking Apples

1. The natural flavor of apples should be developed. This means little added spice or flavouring.
2. Whenever possible, cook

apples without peeling.

3. When peeling apples drop in cold water to prevent discoloration.

4. Cover saucepan closely when making apple sauce.

5. Sugar toughens cellulose. If sauce is desired, cook without sugar, adding it when apples are cooked. Less sugar will be required. If whole pieces are preferred, make a syrup and cook apples in it.

6. Bake apples in a moderate oven 350 degrees F. to prevent skin breaking.

Apple-Ginger Up Side Down Cake

3 tablespoons butter
1/2 cup brown sugar
3 apples
1/4 cup mild-flavoured fat
3 tablespoons white sugar
1 egg
1/2 cup molasses
1 cup sifted pastry flour OR
1 cup less 2 tablespoons sifted all-purpose flour
1 teaspoon baking powder
1/2 teaspoon baking soda
1/8 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon ginger
1/2 teaspoon cinnamon
1/2 cup boiling water

Melt butter in baking dish. Add brown sugar and cook together for 2 or 3 minutes. Peel, core and slice apples. Arrange apple slices in butter and sugar mixture. Cream fat and white sugar together. Add well-beaten egg or molasses. Beat thoroughly. Sift dry ingredients and add to mixture. Lastly add boiling

water, mixing quickly. Pour over apples in baking dish and bake in moderate oven 350 degrees F. for about 40 minutes. Six servings.

Apple Meringue Pie

Pie paste
2 large apples, sliced
2 egg yolks
1/2 cup sugar
1 cup milk
2 egg whites
2 tablespoons sugar

Line a 9-inch pie plate with the paste. Peel, core and slice apples and place in the pie shell. Beat egg yolks, add sugar and milk. Pour this mixture over apples. Bake in hot oven 450 degrees F., for 10 minutes, then reduce temperature to 325 degrees and bake 30 minutes longer. Top with meringue made from the 2 egg whites and the 2 tablespoons of sugar. Return to moderately slow oven, 325 degrees F., to brown meringue. Yield: one 9-inch pie.

HOW CAN I ???

Q. How can I clean the sink drain properly?

A. Take 2 quarts of boiling water and 1/2-can of strong lye, or potash. Pour this into the sink wastepipe at night when leaving the kitchen.

Q. How can I give an added gloss to the linen?

A. A gloss can be produced by making the hot starch with soapy water. This also prevents the iron from sticking to the goods.

Q. How can I improve the flavor and the texture of fudge?

A. Both the flavor and the texture will be improved if a small spoonful of cornstarch is added.

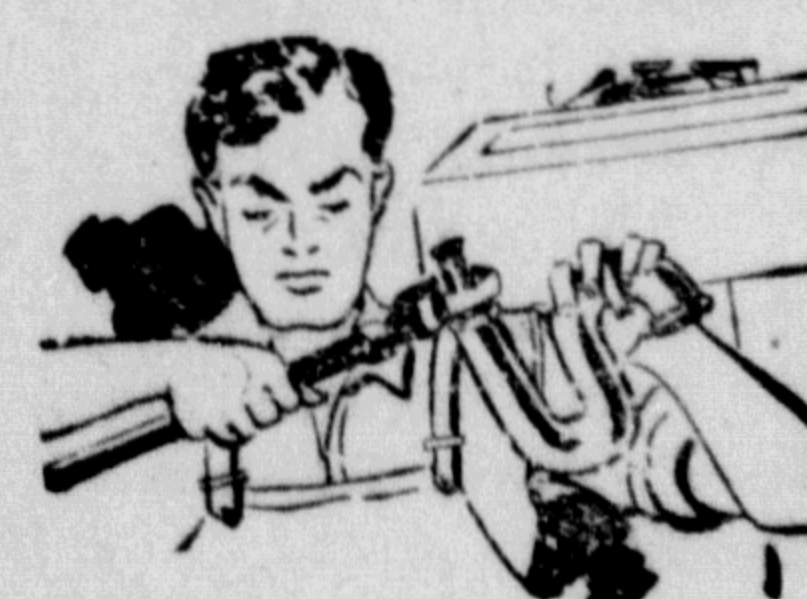

SAMPLER QUESTIONS

Inquiries About Locae Ore Plant in Legislature

The Minister of Mines in the

provincial government was recently asked a number of questions by W. D. Smith, member for Atlin, relating to the establishment of a sampling plant at Prince Rupert, in August 1937. The minister's replies were to the general effect that the plant was built to encourage development work by prospector-owners by the purchase of small lots of ore and to stimulate development in the country adjacent to the Canadian National Railways. It seemed to stimulate interest to some extent for about three years but in the biggest year the tonnage handled amounted to less than one-half the amount estimated as necessary to justify the service. The following tonnage of ore was purchased: 1938, 104 tons; 1939, 217 tons; 1940, 171 tons; 1941, 119 tons; 1942, 30 tons; 1943, 1.6 tons; 1944, 3.5 tons; and 1945, 22 tons. Since then the building has been demolished and the equipment stored in Prince Rupert for possible future use.
