

Luxury Holiday Liner Corsair Coming Here-Speeding Up of Orders Would Facilitate Local Shipments

The luxury yacht Corsair, formerly the property of J. Pierpont Morgan, will sail from San Francisco June 18 on a cruise to Alaska, the cruise to conclude at Vancouver June 30. For the rest of the summer Corsair will run between Vancouver, Prince Rupert and Northern B. C. and Alaskan ports. She has accomodation for 85 passengers.

Taking over the Vancouver-Prince Rupert-Stewart route in place of the Coquitlam which is being transferred to the Queen Charlotte Island run, Union steamer Cardena, Capt. John BOND SUITS Boden, arrived in port at 11 o' clock last night from the south, sailing early this morning for Alice Arm, Stewart and other northern points. The vessel is! due back here tomorrow morning to sail at 1:30 p.m. for Vancouver and waypoints. The Cardena had on board a large number of workers for the Torbrit mine at Alice Arm.

With a capacity list of 118 passengers including Alaskans and Yukoners returning north after spending the winter in the south, C.P.R. steamer Princess Norah, Capt. Graham Hughes, Inlaid Linoleum with Burlap | arrived in port at 8:45 Sunday morning and sailed just an hour later for Skagway and other Alaska points whence she is due back here Thursday afternoon southbound. After this voyage the Princess Norah will be replaced for the remainder of the spring on the Alaska run by the Princess Louise. Sixteen took passage from here for the north on the Norah, one disembarkin at this port.


