with having been given the franchise in British Columbia, might give natives in this province full citizenship rights. The bill would affect every native in Canada.

He explained that under present circumstances the only way a native could gain full citizenship was to first have the approval of the Indian agent and to waive all aboriginal claims. This meant he would have to get permission to visit his family on the reserve.

He thought native schools should be controlled by the provinces and said there had been numerous petitions go to the Dominion government urging that necessary action be taken to bring that point into effect.

Calder intends to spend the whole summer doing research work among his constituents, particularly in the more sparsely settled sections of the north. He hopes his studies in sociology will help him gain a better idea of their needs so that he may be a more useful member for them.

Next week he starts a tour of the Skeena with Arthur Turner, M.L.A. Vancouver Centre.

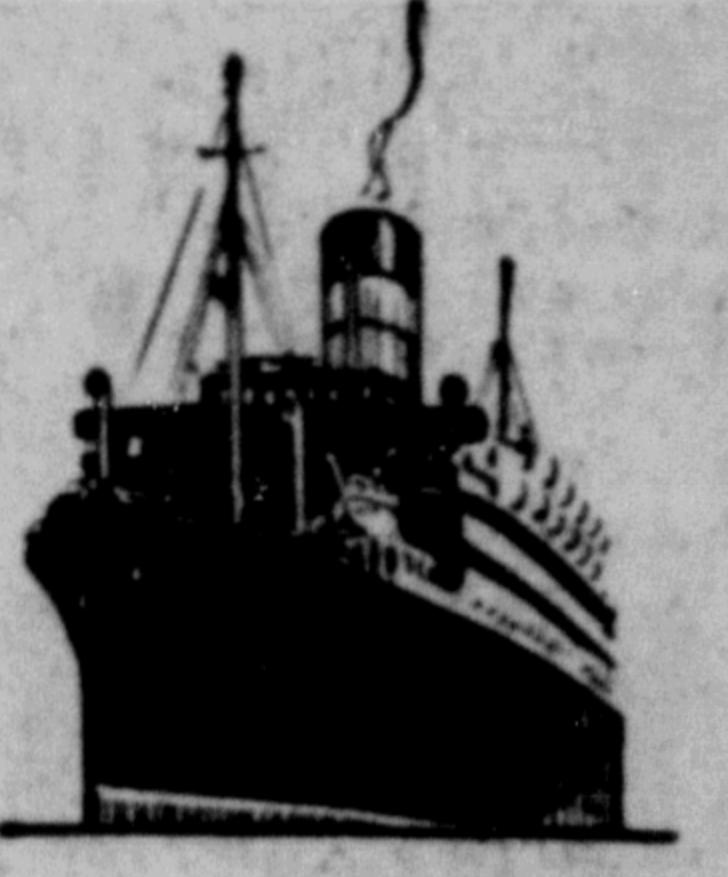
