HOW CAN I ???

Q. How can I remove coffee stains from silk or woolen fabrics?

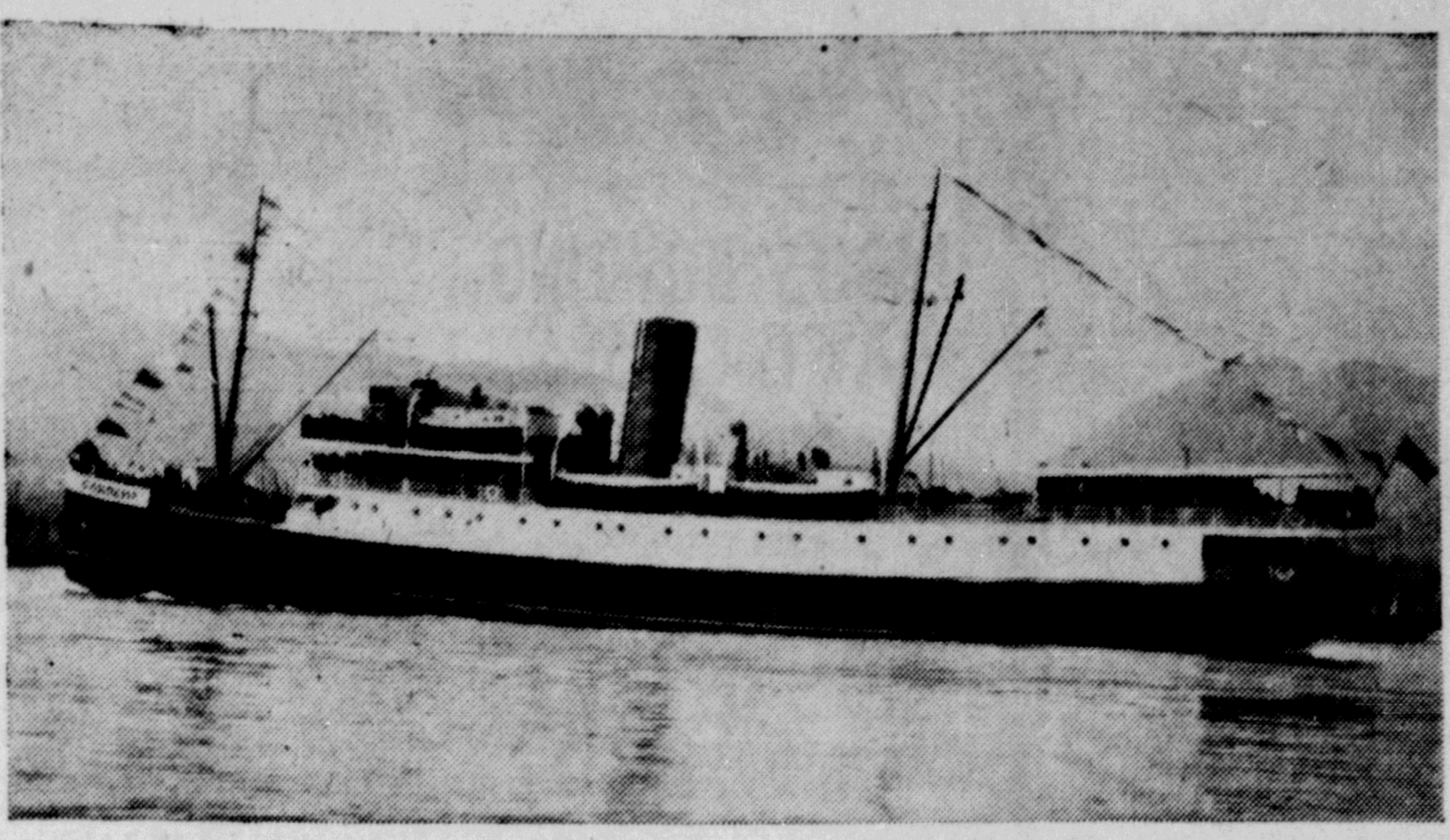

young artist was a popular gesture. "Shepherd's Dance" from German's "Henry VIII Dances," with its swinging rhythm, and Schubert's "Marche Militaire," (an encore) rounded out the first half of the program in a happy manner.
 The repertoire entered into a more technically exacting interweaving of the instruments in the opening group of the second half with Brahms' "Hungarian Dance No. 5 in F Sharp Minor," Greig's haunting "Solveig's Song from "Peer Gynt," and Brahms' famous and always acceptable "Lullaby."
 Miss Grace L. Merrill, Prince Rupert's latest vocal find and an entirely delightful one, was in sweet and dexterous voice as she sang, to the accompaniment of Mrs. J. C. Gilker, Eva Lane Wilson's "Carmena," Eva Dell Acqua's "Villanelle" and Harford Marshall's "I Hear You Calling Me," the last mentioned for an encore. Bouquets were appropriately enough presented to both singer and accompanist. To bring the program to conclusion on a high note and with a taste for more, the final offer-

ings were Ivanovici's rolling "Danube Waves" waltz and Chopin's "Polonaise Militaire," which was a happy climax giving the orchestra full scope for its sweep and power. The overture to "The Caliph of Bagdad" (Boieldieu) was the encore response.
