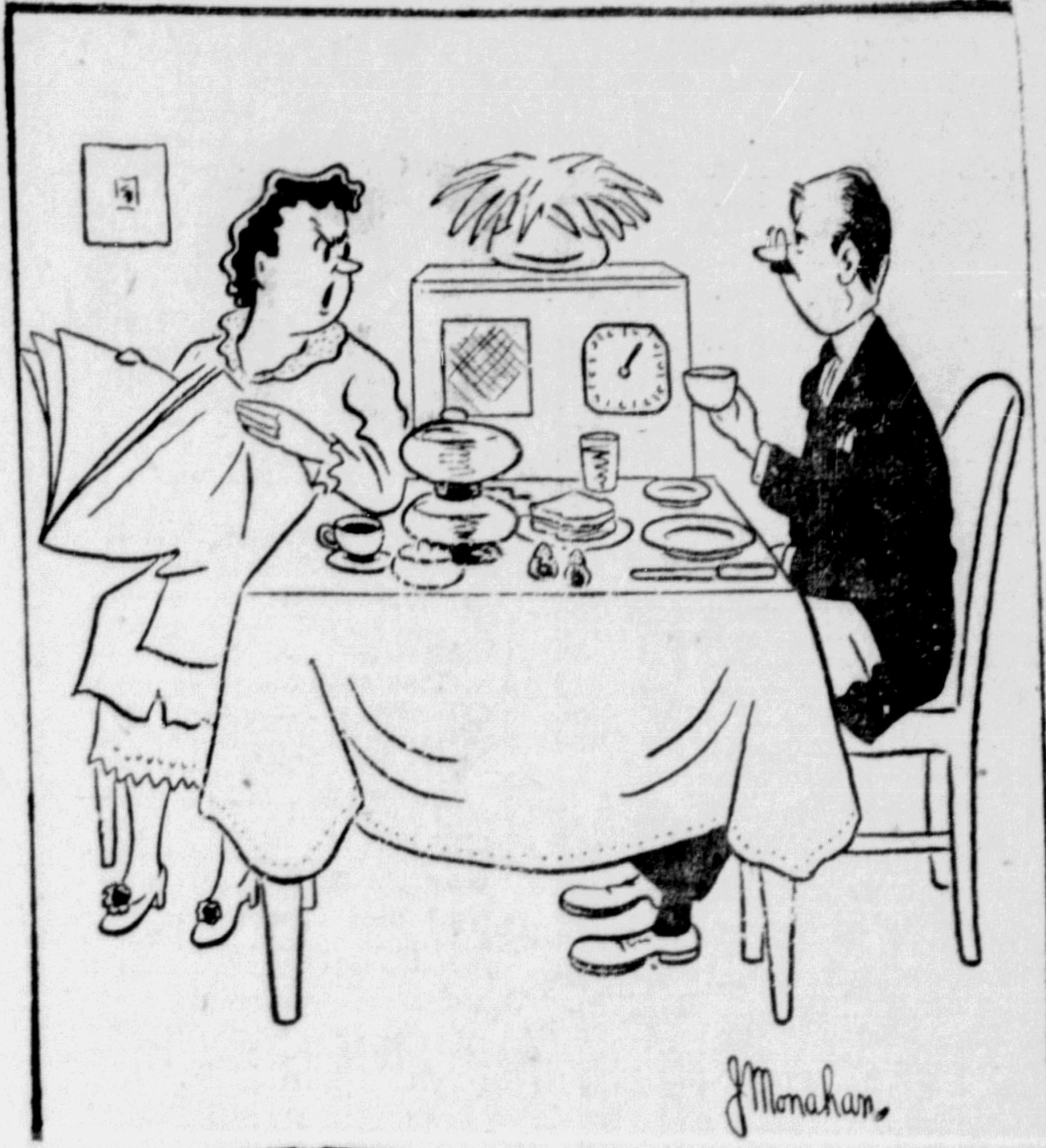

Rutabaga—turnip, you—just another lowly vegetable that has climbed the ladder and changed its name while it now graces the plates of home economists. The turnip's most popular use still remains alongside the potato at dinner. Over-cooking may often be the cause of strongly-flavored turnips, just as with other vegetables. Turnips should be cooked for 30 to 40 minutes in a small amount of water in a covered pot until just tender-crisp. Turnips, sliced thinly, or coarsely with little boiling water, will cook to perfection in seven minutes. TURNIPS—Slice raw turnips and place in layers in a casserole. Sprinkle each layer with salt, pepper and a dash of onion. Add milk to half the dish. Top with crumbs and dot with fat, or use crumbs and grated cheese. Bake in a moderately hot oven—375 degrees Fahrenheit—until tender (about 40 minutes). TURNIPS—Slice raw turnips and place in layers in a casserole. Sprinkle each layer with salt, pepper and a dash of onion. Add milk to half the dish. Top with crumbs and dot with fat, or use crumbs and grated cheese. Bake in a moderately hot oven—375 degrees Fahrenheit—until tender (about 40 minutes).

Use the correct oven temperature for various types of food is imperative if the cooked food is to be at its best. The recognized oven temperatures: 300 degrees Fahrenheit—slow oven; 325—moderately slow; 350—moderate; 375—moderately hot; 400—hot; 425—very hot. Cereals, meringues, baked custards and soup will cook slowly in the heat remaining in an oven that has been turned off. Melba toast, celery leaves, or parsley may be dried as the temperature decreases, thus utilizing all the heat.

It is as near the exact centre of the oven as possible. Two layer cakes should be placed on the shelf so that they do not touch each other or the sides of the oven.

The recognized oven temperatures: 300 degrees Fahrenheit—slow oven; 325—moderately slow; 350—moderate; 375—moderately hot; 400—hot; 425—very hot. METLAKATLA
BEATS SIMPSON

Two Port Simpson basketball teams which invaded Metlakatla Thursday night were stopped short by their hosts at the Holy City. Port Simpson Athletic Club seniors came out on the short end of a 55-52 score while the visiting intermediate team lost by a score of 68-59. In the senior game, close checking by both teams kept the score low in the early periods. First period score was 6-6. The second period started off at a terrific pace and Port Simpson began finding the range of the hoop. Nine field baskets and five successful penalty shots rewarded their accuracy. Half-time score was 29-18 for Port Simpson. In the third period, the Metlakatla got into the groove, marking up 24 points on field shots and one penalty counter. Port Simpson scored 16 points during the period to bring the third-quarter score to 45-43 for visitors. In the final quarter, Metlakatla forged ahead but lost their advantage with Port Simpson tying the score 49-48 late in the period. A surge by the home team, however, gave them a three-point advantage at the final whistle. High scorer for the evening was C. Nelson, of Metlakatla, with 21 points. E. Sampson was top man for Port Simpson with 19 points. Referee Reg Sampson handed out 21 personal penalties against Metlakatla and 14 against Port Simpson. J. Wilson, of Metlakatla, was banished when he garnered five blackies. Intermediate Game Port Simpson made a strong start in the Intermediate encounter, reaching the end of the first quarter with a 13-7 advantage. Metlakatla retaliated in the opening moments of the second quarter to tie the score at 13-13 and the close of the period saw equality maintained with a 22-22 score. The hectic third period saw Metlakatla score 30 points while the hard-working visitors strove but failed to keep up. They did, however, score 19. Third quarter mark-up was 52-41 for Metlakatla. 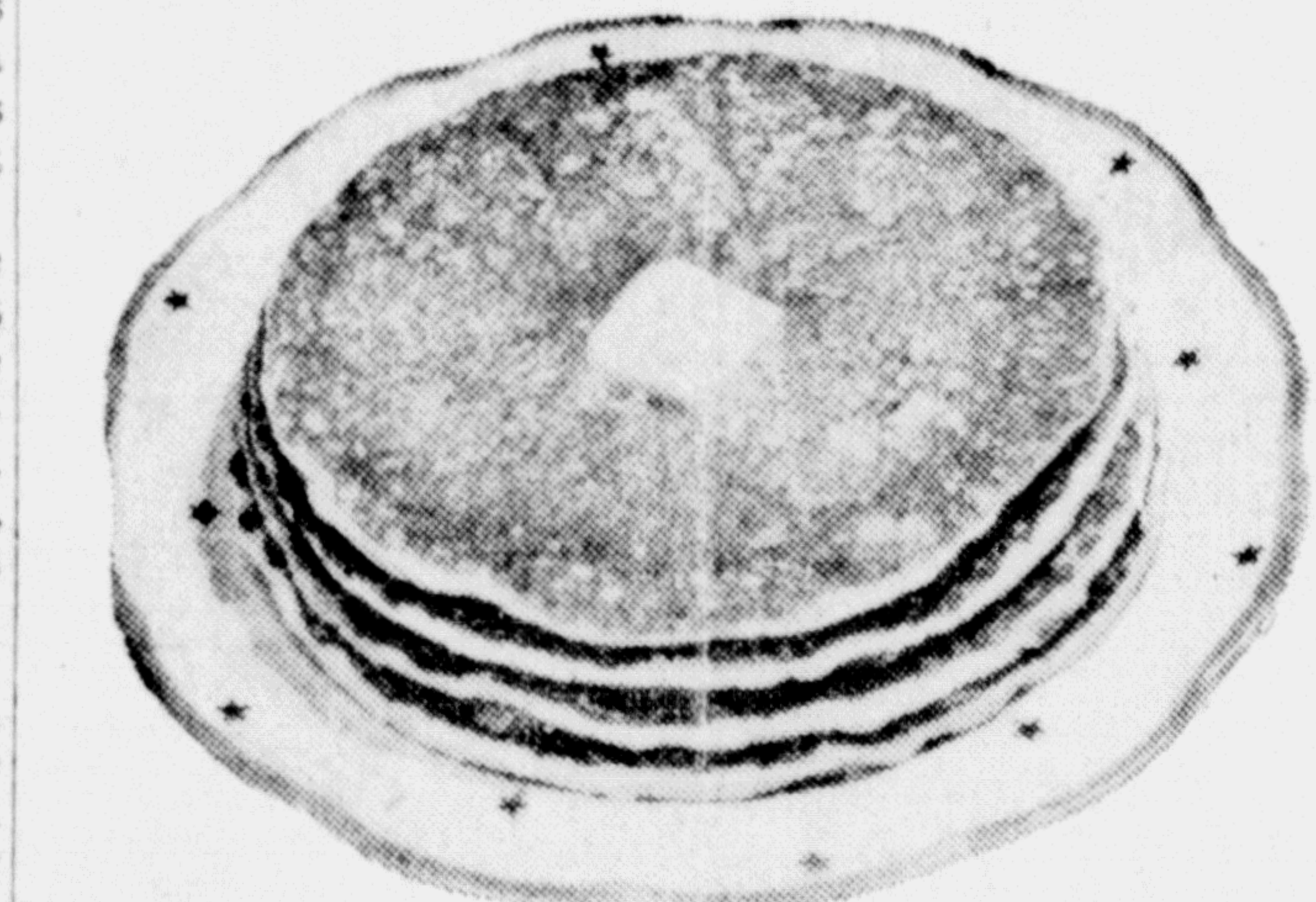

EASY PANCAKE RECIPE
FOR SHROVE TUESDAY

Here's a good basic recipe that makes 14 to 16 medium pancakes. 2 cups pancake mix—2 1/4 cups milk. 1. Just add milk to unsifted pancake mix all at once and stir lightly. 2. Pour 1/4 cup of batter for each pancake onto a hot, lightly greased griddle. 3. Bake to a golden brown, turning only once. For extra rich pancakes, add one beaten egg and 2 tablespoons melted butter or other fat to pancake batter. For Buckwheat Cakes, use 2 cups Buckwheat ready-mix and 2 1/2 cups milk, following the above directions.
