

VIKING SHIP PREPARES TO INVADE ENGLAND—This is an artist's impression of the Viking ship now being built at Frederikssund, Denmark, for use when the Viking landing on England's coast is re-enacted on July 28. The ship is 24 metres long and weighs 15 tons and, since it is also to sail to London, has a mast which can be lowered to permit passage under the Thames bridges. The new "invasion" is being planned by the British and Danish Travel associations to commemorate the 15th centenary of the original Viking invasion of Britain.

Seasonable Ideas for Housekeepers

Berry-time is here. It is a joy to the homemaker to have strawberries, raspberries, blackberries, loganberries and blueberries follow in quick succession, making desserts no problem for the next few weeks. Some families are satisfied to have fresh red-ripe straw-

berries with cream served three times a day while the season lasts. Old fashioned strawberry short cake is always tops. Double crust strawberry pie "like mother used to make", may be dad's choice while teen-agers rave about Raspberry Chiffon Pie:

Home economists have many tested recipes using berries in various ways.

Plain cake served warm with a topping or sauce of sweetened crushed berries, is equally good with all types of berries.

Genuine strawberry short cake is not a cake but a baking powder biscuit baked in two layers served hot and well buttered, with berries lightly crushed and sweetened between and on top. It should be served with rich cream but not whipped. This masterpiece of cookery is supposed to have originated in the State of Maine and was originally a breakfast dish. Elsewhere, however, it is usually a dessert.

Berry Pie Filling
4 cups berries (strawberries, raspberries, blackberries, huckleberries)

3/4 cup sugar
3 tablespoons flour
1 teaspoon quick-cooking tapioca

1 teaspoon lemon juice
1/2 teaspoon nutmeg
2 tablespoons butter
Uncooked pastry shell

Mix together all ingredients except the fruit and butter.

Crumb Berry Pudding
1/2 cup fine dry bread crumbs
1/2 cup quick-cooking rolled oats

1 cup sour milk
1/4 cup shortening
1/2 cup brown sugar

1/2 cup sifted all-purpose flour

1/2 teaspoons baking powder
1/4 teaspoon soda
1/4 teaspoon salt

1 cup berries (strawberries, blueberries or raspberries)

Soak crumbs and rolled oats in sour milk for 1 1/2 to 2 hours.

Cream shortening and sugar. Sift together the flour, baking powder, soda and salt. Add berries to dry ingredients and add alternately with crumb mixture to the creamed fat and sugar mixture. Blend thoroughly. Fill individual moulds two-thirds full. Bake in a moderately hot oven, 375 degrees F.,

40 minutes; cake pan, 40 to 45 minutes. Serve cold with sweetened crushed berries. Yield: 8 servings.
