### CHOCOLATE CREAM PIE

1 baked pastry shell (9")  
2 cups scalded milk  
2 (1-oz. squares) grated unsweetened chocolate  
1/2 cup Crown Brand Corn Syrup  
1/2 cup white sugar  
1/2 tsp. salt  
3/4 tsp. Borden's Corn Starch  
1/2 tsp. salt  
1/2 cup cold milk  
1 egg, separated  
1 tsp. butter (optional)  
1 tsp. vanilla

Heat milk in top of double boiler over boiling water; add grated chocolate. Blend Borden's Corn Starch and salt with cold milk; add to hot mixture and cook, stirring constantly, until smooth and thick. Cover and continue cooking 10 minutes. Add well-beaten egg yolks and cook 2 minutes longer. Remove from heat, add butter and vanilla. Beat until creamy. Pour into 9" baked shell and top with meringue prepared from the two egg whites remaining.
