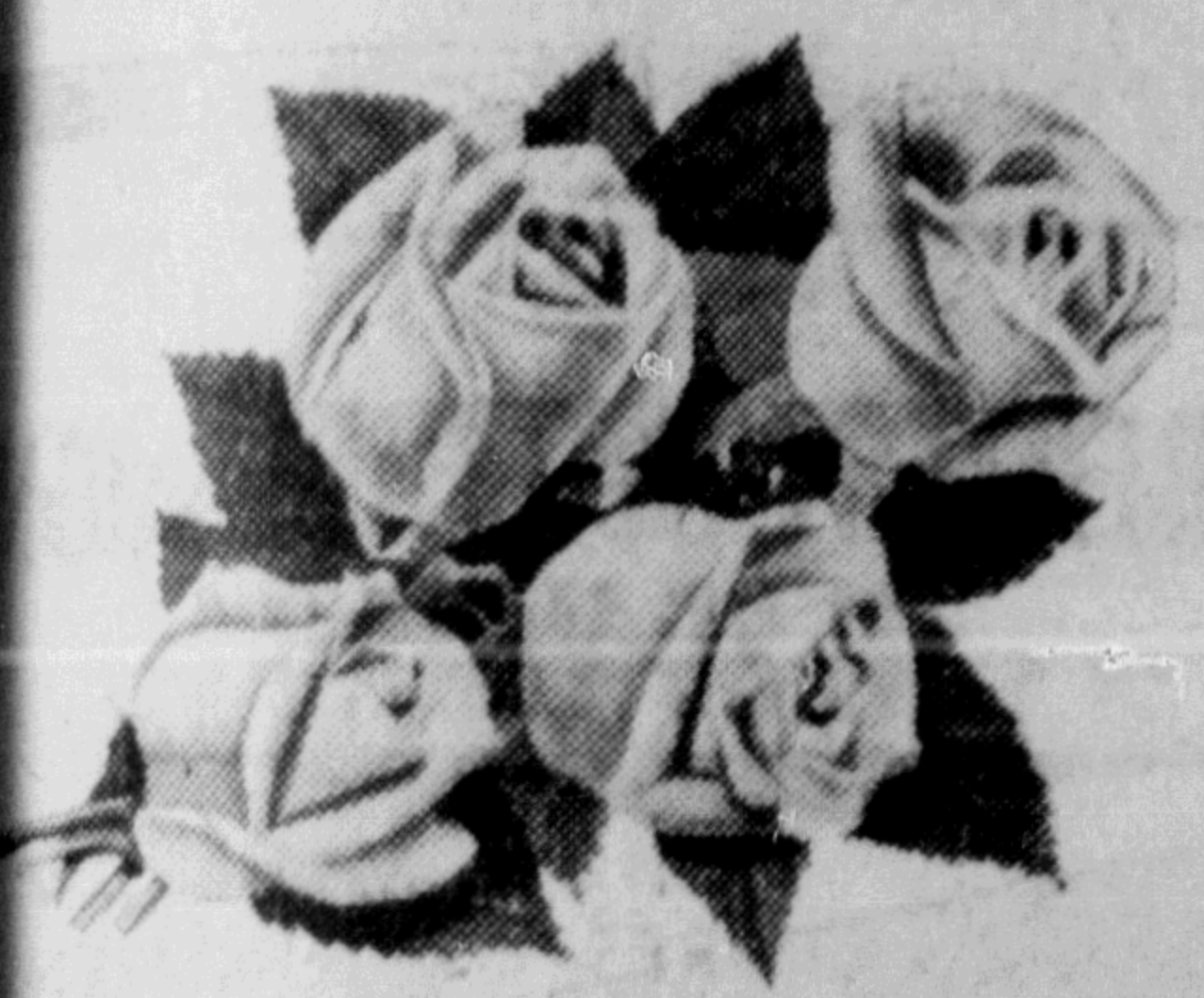

Good Fishing In Area Two

Smaller two-man vessels are catching up to 11,500 pounds of halibut daily in the waters of Area No. 2 about 30 miles west of Prince Rupert between Rose Spit and Triple Island. The larger boats are running fair catches and weather conditions in that area are good, it is reported.

In Area No. 3, between Cape Spencer and Cape Sarichef on Unimak Island, the waters are being fished mostly by American and Vancouver vessels. Only two halibut boats cleared out of Prince Rupert for Area No.

SYDNEY, Australia (The Australian Federal Parliamentary Labor Party today decided to endorse the principles of the Coalition Government's bill to outlaw Communism. Meanwhile, at pit top meetings this morning, miners in 50 of 115 mines in New South Wales voted against their Communist-led union's order to strike for one day in protest against the bill.
