SHIPS and WATERFRONT

Bringing north the Vancouver Board of Trade goodwill tour party and general traffic, C.N.R. steamer Prince George will be arriving in port from Vancouver May 17 in place of the Prince Rupert for one voyage. The Prince George will make the regular run to Ketchikan and back here Thursday night southbound. She will be arriving in Vancouver in the morning of Saturday instead of the usual afternoon time as she has to leave again for the north the same night, May 20, with the annual Portland Journal of Commerce Alaska tour party.

C.N.R. steamer Prince Rupert, Capt. E. B. Caldwell, arrived in port at 11:45 yesterday morning from Vancouver, Ocean Falls and waypoints, sailing for Ketchikan at midnight. The vessel returns to Prince Rupert
