Floral Pets Provide Message For Moderns

"The Plant in the Window" Book by Canadian Writer in New York

NEW YORK (P)—Ross Parmenter, a Canadian who works for the New York Times, found a bedraggled philodendron in his apartment. He became so interested in the plant that "he wrote a book about it."

The book—"The Plant in My Window" is being published here by Thomas Y. Crowell Company. It is a more-or-less chronological report of the philodendron's growth and the things Parmenter learned about and from it.

"Whether he knows it or not, a man needs to be close to growing things," he writes. And he uses the lessons he learned from watching his plant develop to explain why humans act the way they do.

Parmenter, a son of the late R. H. Parmenter, K. C., of Toronto, was graduated from the University of Toronto in 1933 and became a reporter on the Toronto Evening Telegram. Now he is a concert reviewer and Sunday columnist for the New York Times, but retains his Canadian citizenship.

INDOOR GARDENERS

One of the surprising things he learned, says Parmenter, was the vast number of indoor gardeners. People turning from pets to plants because modern living makes it hard to keep animals.

"People turn to plants to gain some fulfillment for basic psychological needs," he writes.

ship in our inner lives. We have less sense of home in the places where we live. We find less and less satisfaction in our work. The world seems to grow increasingly ugly. Our sense of any control over our destiny steadily diminishes. Joy has gone from us.

"And in remaking the world in the likeness of a steam-heated air-conditioned metropolis of apartment buildings we have violated one of our essential attributes—our kinship with nature."
