4. A feeling that something will happen. "All presentiments that are confirmed by events, give man a higher idea of himself.—Goethe.

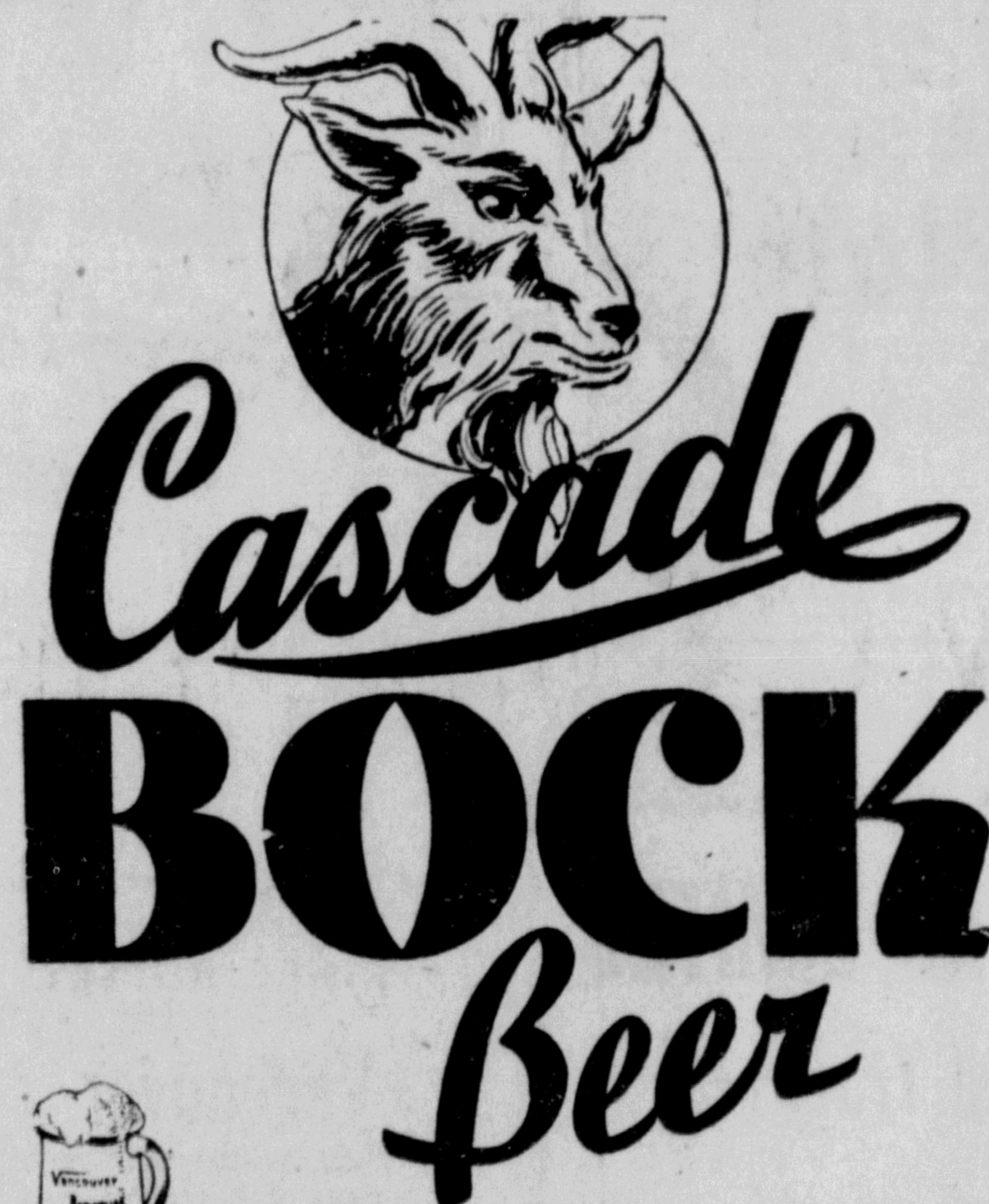
