**REGULAR BAPTIST CHRISTMAS TREE**  
Fine Program Enthusiastically Rendered and Much Enjoyed  
A capacity crowd of well over two hundred filled the Regular Baptist Church Friday evening to enjoy the Christmas program presented by the children of the Sunday School and Mission Band.
