Catholic Church does not look upon the Virgin Mary as a goddess. She is a creature. An infinite distance separates her from the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. She has no grace, no virtue, no privilege which she does not owe to God. It is as true of her as of every other human being, that, without God, she can do nothing. His might, His power, His love made her what she is; it was from His bounty that she received the signal privileges that make her the most glorious representative of the human race. Although the Catholic prays to her and seeks her favor, he knows that the Virgin Mary can do more than plead his cause before her Divine Son.

Yet in the sphere of excellence obtainable by a creature, how outstanding, how majestic she is! First of all, she alone of all the children of Adam was conceived immaculate. You know that through Adam's fall every one born into this world comes burdened with the effects of original sin. For a period of our lives until Baptism, we are utterly without God's grace—AM. except the Virgin Mary, who through a singular privilege, was exempt from the common lot of mankind. This is her first title to greatness. Not only that, however, but hers was emphatically the path of the just and sinlessness in thought, word and deed, in small things and in great, attended her until she breathed her last breath. As the poet Wordsworth puts it, she is the

"Mother whose virgin bosom was uncorrupted"
By the least shade of thought to sin allied,
Woman above all women glorified,
Our tainted natures' solitary boast."

This unrivalled virtue in itself

would make her worthy of our admiration. If we pay homage to patriots, if we honor heroism, if we recognize achievement, surely this woman who is the very embodiment of goodness has a special claim on our admiration. We all know the constancy, the strength of character that are needed if we are to persevere in well-doing. Only all too often, we have to admit that, in spite of our goodwill, we fall short of the perfect accomplishment of duty to God. Here is a woman, who, from first to last, was without fault, entirely without blame.

However, the Virgin Mary was called to fill a unique role in the world. We Christians, believe that the Divine Son of God became Man. He was God from all eternity but He was born a babe in Bethlehem. He had a mother and that mother was the Virgin Mary. Here is another reason why she is entitled to honor. She is the Mother of God. She must have been of singular worth to have been chosen from all the women of the world to be the mother of the Redeemer.

Is it any wonder that we believe and know she is able to intercede with God on behalf of those living on earth? The Bible tells us that if a man or a worshiper of God and do as will, God will hear him and if the continual prayer of a just man availeth much, if patient Job was able to have his prayers heard because he had spoken right things before God, why should we wonder on hearing that Mary, the Mother of God, should have influence in heaven? Let me say again that no attribute of the Virgin Mary any power of her own and the prayer which we constantly say to her is proof of it: Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us, sinners, now and at the hour of our death."

the testimony of an unbiased witness. John Ruskin, the famous English critic, wrote:
