

It may be said that there is already a station at Smithers. but Smithers is 141 miles fron Terrace and as between the two locations there is a tremendous difference in the terrain. The type of farming carried on a Smithers is largely grain and stockraising, whereas the type of farming carried on at Terrace is the growing of fruits and vegetables. Terrace is the growing area possibly closest to the Pacific coast and it can readily supply the market of Prince Rupert. I request that the minister give consideration to this matter
