## BLACK BEAR SHOT ON 11TH AVENUE

### FORBES LEE FINALLY LAYS BRUIN LOW

Two blasts from a 12-gauge shotgun in the hands of Forbes H. Lee ended the marauding career of a 180-pound black bear last night on Eleventh Avenue.

From time to time during the past two months the bear has been seen by residents of the Eleventh Avenue district. One of his particular haunts was the Hays Creek area below Mc-Clymont Park and one time he apparently roamed as far afield as Sixth Avenue near upper Ambrose for, Tom McKeown reported seeing a black bear in that vicinity about two weeks ago.

At one time Ed. Martin, the game warden, spent some time trying to track the bruin but concluded he had left for other parts when no trace of the bear was found. For a time things were relatively quiet out, during the last week or so, people living on Eleventh Avenue were disturbed at night by the bear's foraging jaunts.

A week ago Wednesday night he raided the carrot patch in James L. Lee's garden. At that time Forbes Lee walked out the back door of the house and came face to face with the bear but, before he could go back for his gun, the intruder was lost in the gloom and bush.

As the bear was considered a nuisance and a danger young Lee obtained a special permit to shoot the animal. Tuesday night he sat up late waiting for the carrot stealer but nothing happened. Last night he had about given up and went to bed but he hadn't been there long when he heard the bear in the back yard. He raced downstairs and out the back door with his shotgun and, by the light of the moon, he took aim at close range, letting go with both barrels. The charge wasn't enough to kill the bear outright and he headed for the bush. In pyjamas and gumboots and with a flashlight, Forbes tried to locate the wounded animal but, when a preliminary search failed to reveal the bear, he decided to wait

for the light of day before going into the thick growth after him.

This morning the furry carcass was found about 100 yards from the spot where he had been shot. The trophy of the chase is now at Atlin Fisheries and, according to some of the local hunters, the bear is a bit short of being a year old. For those who care for bear meat there will probably be some steaks and it looks as though the Lee household will shortly be graced with a handsome black bear rug.
