## RED CROSS DRIVE HALF-WAY MARK

Will Continue Until Quota  
of \$3000 is Met

Despite the fact that Prince Rupert's Red Cross fund-raising drive has passed its three-week initial time schedule, the campaign will continue until the area's \$3,000 quota is filled, according to S. H. Saville, chairman.

Mr. Saville said Tuesday afternoon that so far the city had contributed \$1,433, slightly less than half of its quota.

"We will continue it at least until the end of the month, possibly longer if the quota is not filled by that time, he said.

City canvassers, numbering about 20, have covered practically all the residential areas of the city as well as the business district. Some have made "excellent" returns while others have not been so good.

Still to come in are contributions from outlying localities—the Queen Charlotte Islands, Butedale, Namu and other villages. Irregular boat service has hampered the return of contributions from these points.

"This year's quota of \$3,000 is only slightly more than half of that of last year," Mr. Saville said. "We met last year's quota without much difficulty. Surely we can do it again."

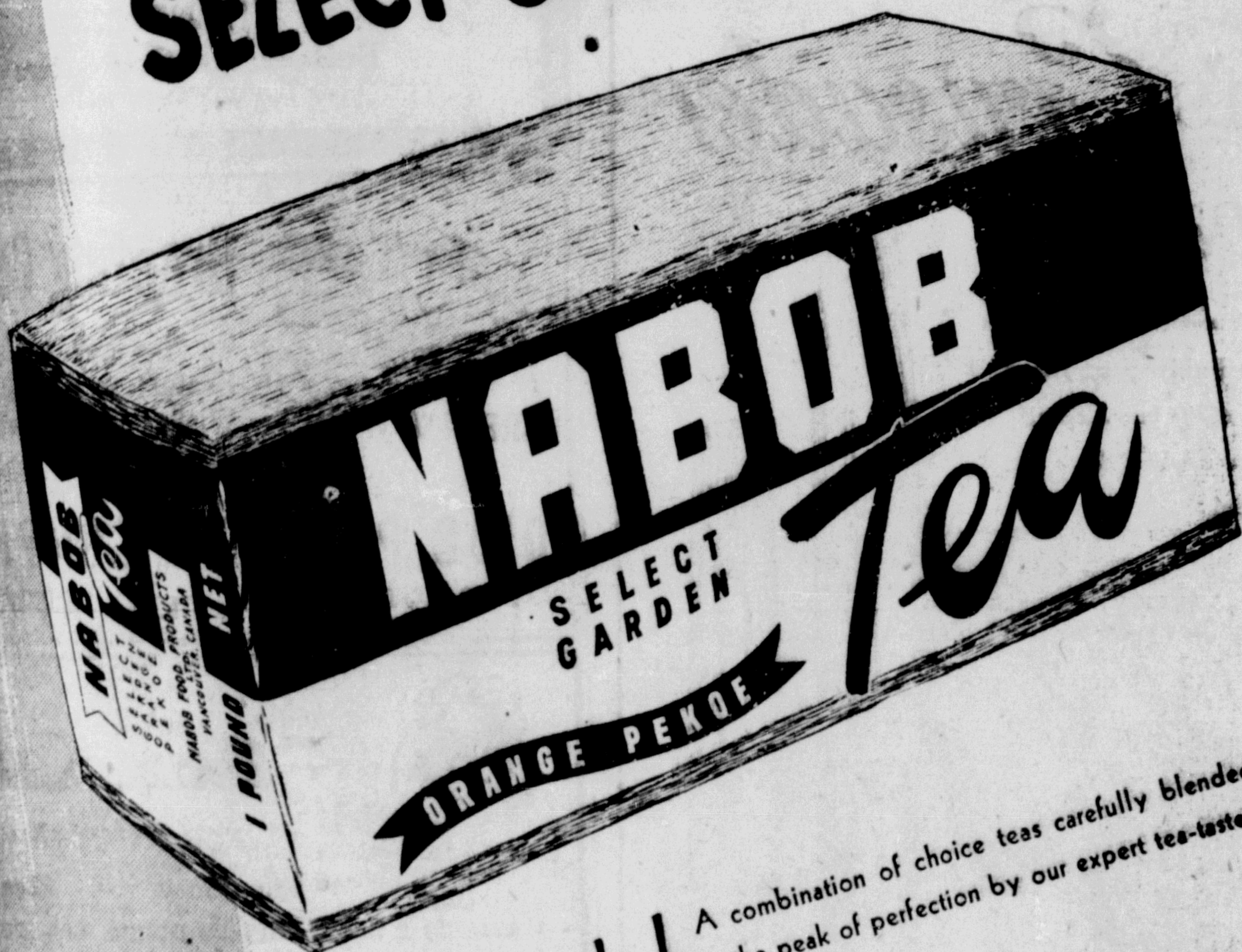
