THE "BRIGGS PLAN"

In March this year the British government appointed a "strong man" to co-ordinate the campaign against the terrorists.

They chose Lt.-Gen. Sir Harold Rawson Briggs, 55-year-old wartime army commander in the Middle and Far East. He formulated the widely-publicized "Briggs Plan." Its details have never been officially made known, but its mainspring was understood to be the "domination of populated areas."

Security forces believed the terrorists could not have held out for so long without help from the civilian population. They thought this help came mostly from 300,000 Chinese squatters scattered throughout the peninsula.
