Every citizen of the Province is required to register under the B.C. Hospital Insurance Act.

Residents who have not received forms through the mail and who are not covered as dependents should apply to the local office for a registration form.

Payment of premiums by instalments starts on the first of October and payments should be made to the local office through the mail or in person.

Residents in the Prince Rupert area are advised to register immediately as the closing date for registration in this area is September 30th, 1948. Be sure to register early, returning the completed form to the local office.
