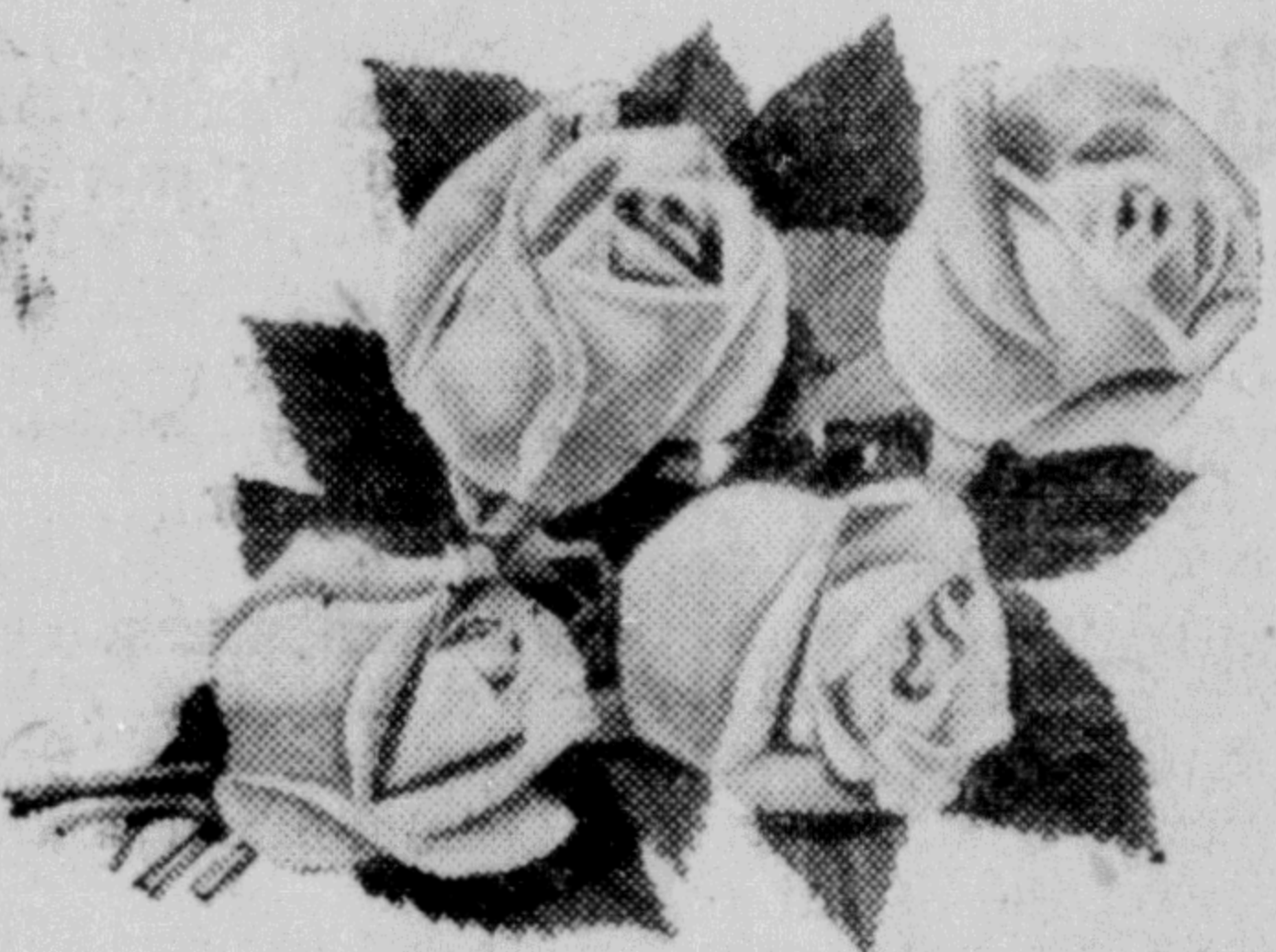
Most Valuable Element Found

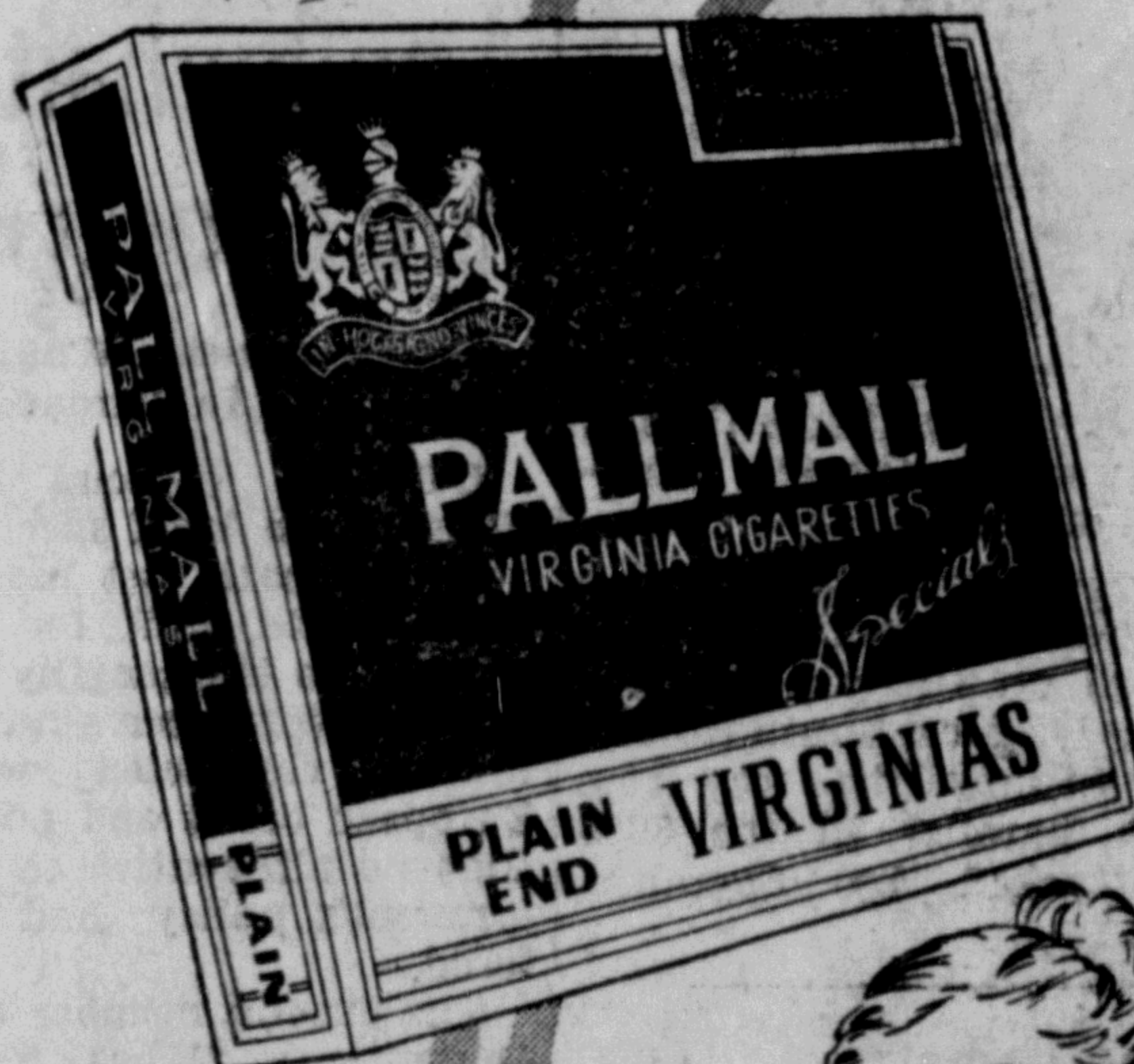

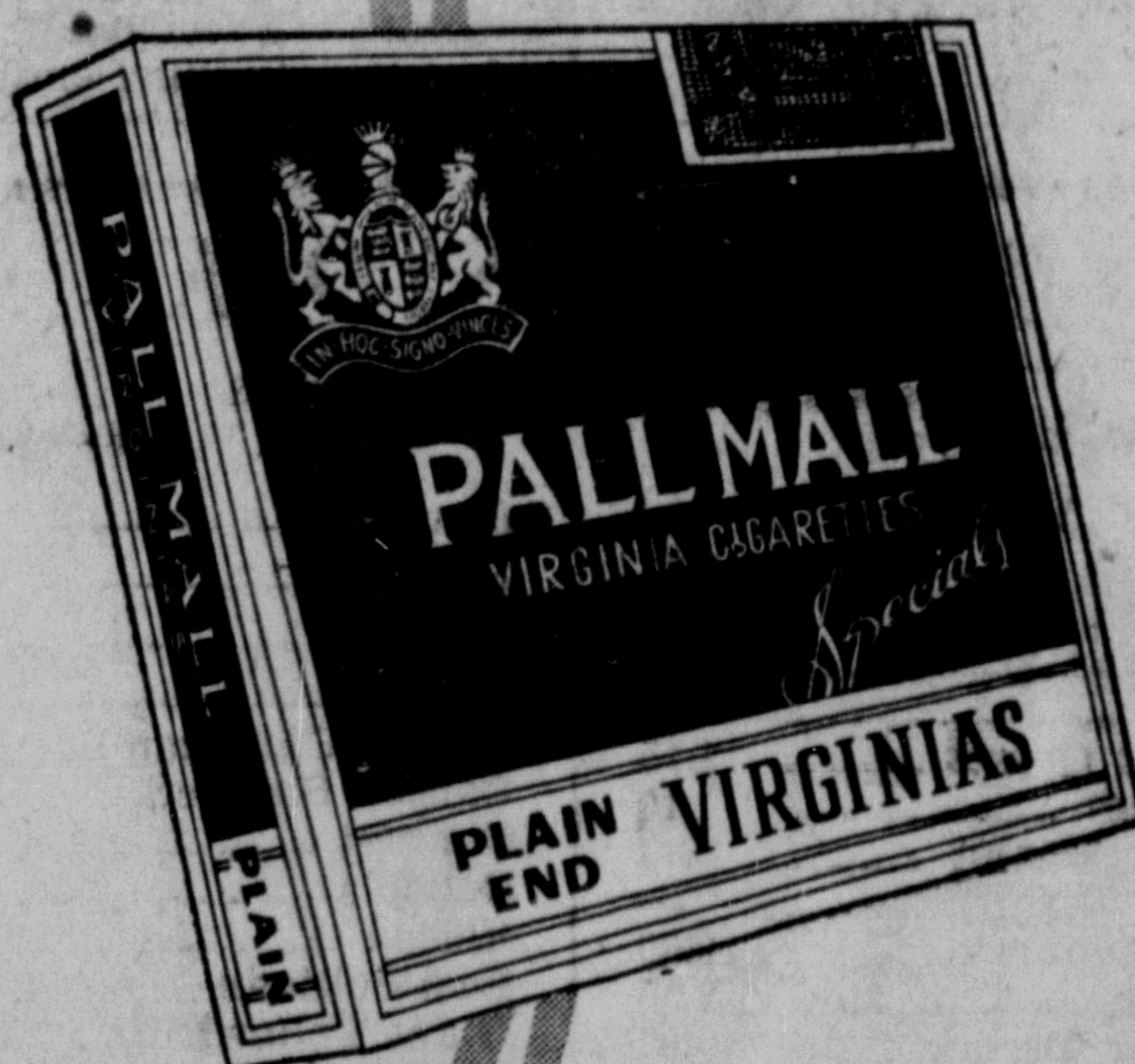
