## SHIPS and WATERFRONT

Dense fog this morning upset the time tables of passenger ships bound up the coast. Union ss Chilcotin, Capt. H. E. McLean, was expected here at 10 a.m. but did not arrive until this afternoon. C.N. ss Prince George, Capt. Eccles, arrived at 1 p.m.

Salmon areas of the Queen Charlotte Islands will close for the week tonight, it was announced this morning. Salmon fishing of the west coast has been exceptionally good with 40 seine boats catching 100,000 chum salmon between them yesterday. Off the east coast 50 seine boats caught 40,000 salmon. The Dominion Fisheries Department has found it necessary to cut down the fishing time each week because modern equipment and methods of fishing are bringing in the fish more quickly. Salmon fishing in the Bella Bella area is tapering off now, and R.C. Edwards of the local staff has gone down to investigate the situation.

International Fisheries Commission chartered vessel Havana, Capt. Harold Hanson, arrived in port this morning. Registered in Seattle, the boat has been engaged in tagging halibut in area two.

The motor ship Dagne, Capt. S. R. Wiks, arrived in port this morning from Ketchikan with a load of canned salmon for transshipment by C.N.R. lines to the United States.

C.N.R. steamer Prince George, Capt. William Eccles, arrived in port from the south yesterday at noon on the first trip as replacement for the Prince Rupert.
